This Day Commences with Light
breezes and Cloudy Weather Wind
from the N.E. steering on the
wind N.W. Middle part fresh
breezes and Clear Weather made all
sail Latter part Light breezes
and Clear Weather Saw nothing
except some kelp at 8 o'clock P.M.
Took in sail heading W.S.W.

Wednesday 16th of Sep. 1840
All this Day fresh breezes from
the W. steering on the wind
N.W. Clear Weather Saw one
fin back and one Killer —
At 6 o'clock Took in sail Lat by Obs 33-36 S

Long by Chron 171-38 W

Thursday 17th of September 1840
This Day Commences with fresh breezes
and Squally Weather steering on the
wind to the N.E. at 8 o'clock backed ship
steering to the W. at Noon waving
Squally Took in sail wind from
the E.N.W. one sail in sight the
Phaenix Bay Harbor & nothing
Lat 33-26

Long 171-30

Friday 18th
First part of this Day Light breezes
and Squally Middle and Latter part
Light breezes from the S.W. steering
on the wind to the W.N.W. pleasant
Weather one ship in sight to the
N. of us. At 6 o'clock Took in sail

Long by Chron 172-02 W

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Saturday 19th of September 1840
All this Day Light breezes from
the W.N.W. first part steering on
the wind N. Latter part S.W. 4 ships
in sight Spake Ship Averick soon
of Bremen (Dutchman)

Saw a school of Killars nothing
more of Whale kind —

At sun set Took in sail heading S.W.

Lat by Obs 32-15 S

Long by Chron 172-15 W

Sunday 20th of Sep. 1840
This Day Commences with fresh
breezes from the N.W. and
Squally Weather made sail steering
on the wind S.W. at 8 o'clock A.M.
very squally, Took in sail
At Noon better Weather made
sail again two sails in sight
Latter part Light breezes and
pleasant steering to the South

At sun set Took in sail Lat by Obs 32-44 S

Long by Chron 173-15 W

Monday 21st of Sep. 1840
Throughout this Day Light breezes
from the S.W. and pleasant Weather
steering on the wind to the S.E.
Saw two fin backs and 5 ships
at 4 o'clock P.M. Spake Ship John
Cogshall New Port nothing this
Season at 6 o'clock P.M. Took in
sail more ship

heading W.S.W. Lat by Obs 33-34 S
