Saturday 10th of October 1840
All this Day Light breezes from the ESE. First part steering on the wind NE latter part S at 6 O'clock P.M. kept off S.W. under all sail the watch employed trying on & pleasant weather
Saw nothing but Din Bucks

Sunday 11th of October 1840
All this Day Light breezes from the N.W. steering of the S.W. very pleasant weather saw three Whale struck and fired one cut him in, stove the L.C.B.

Monday 12th of October 1840
All this Day Light breezes from the W and pleasant weather heading to the S saw four Whale lowered twice got nothing two sails in sight trying the watch employed trying at Sun set took in Top & all but sails by 10 Dark ship heading to the S North

Tuesday 13th of October 1840
All this Day Light breezes from the N.W. and pleasant weather saw several Whale got one cut him in, all hands employed unloading trying on one ship in sight

No Observation this Day

Wednesday 14th of October 1840
All this Day Light breezes from the N.W. and pleasant weather saw a plenty of Whale got one cut him in two sails in sight, no Obs this Day

Thursday 15th of October 1840
All this Day Light breezes from the S and pleasant All hands employed stowing down and whaling saw several Whale got one

Friday 16th of October 1840
First part of this Day Calm and pleasant cut in the Whale &c. Latter part Light breezes from the N.W. heading N.W.E, employed Boyling

Saturday 17th of October 1840
Throughout this Day fresh breezes from the W and Cloudy weather all hands stowing down saw one Whale First part of the Day heading N.W. Latter part S trying out and stowing down No Long
