Monday 19th of October 1840
First part of this Day fresh breezes
from the W and cloudy squally
Weather saw one Whale and two
Ships Lowered and Chast the Whales
but did not get near him the
Watch Employed Boiling

Later part Pleasant, Lat By Ar 33, 30 S

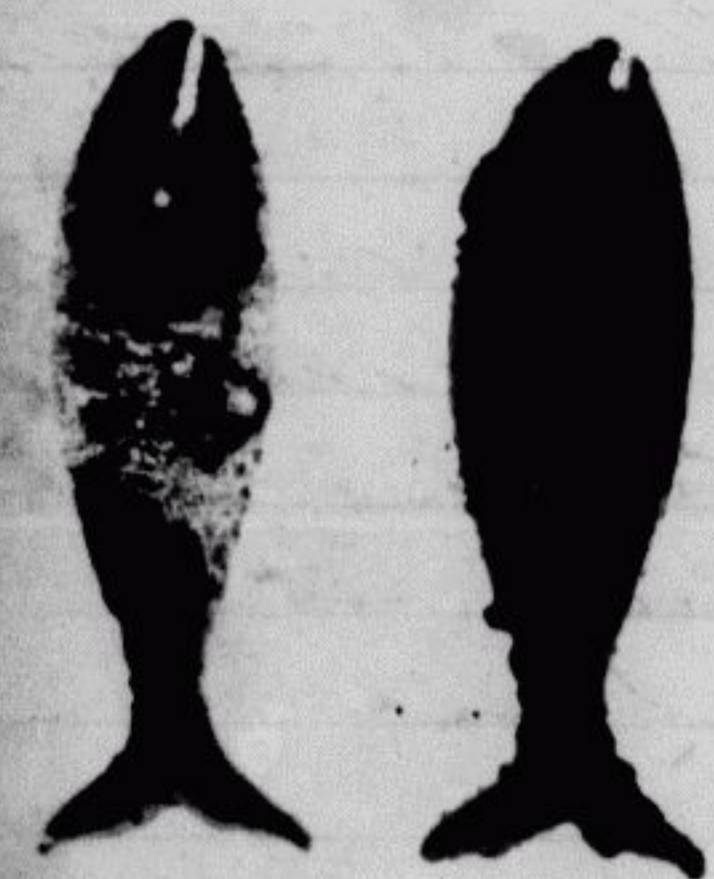
No Longitude

Tuesday 20th of October 1840
Throughout this Day Light breeze
and pleasant weather saw no
Whale except fin backs three Ships
in sight, All hands stowing down
At 6 O'clock P.M. finish Drying
Wind from the N.W. steering
S.W.

Long By Ar 172, 50 W

Wednesday 21st of October 1840
First part of this Day
fresh breezes from the
N.E. steering S.W. All hands
steering home, latter
part more moderate
saw 6 or 8 Whales Struck
2 took 1 along side at
6 O'clock the other at 11 P.M.
took in tail



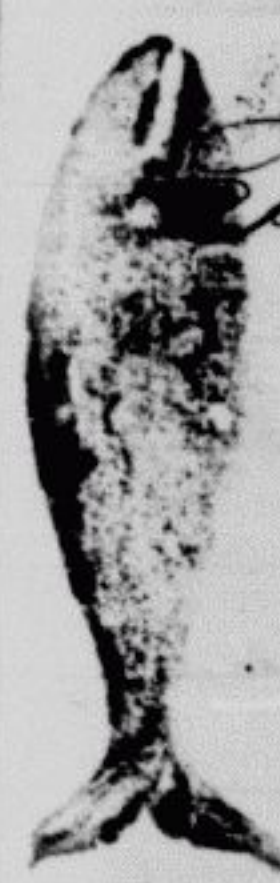
Lat By Ar 33, 09 S

Master a Whaling in the S.P.O.
Thursday 22nd of October 1840

All this Day Light breezes from
the N.E. and pleasant weather
first part out in the 2 Whales latter
Employed Drying and Whaling
Struck 1 Brown Dren got nothing

Lat By Ar 33, 11 S

Long By Ar 172, 13 W



Friday 23rd of October 1840
All this Day Light breeze
and pleasant weather from
the E. saw a great many
Whales got one Put him in
Whaling Boiling etc.



Saturday 24th of October 1840
All this Day Light breezes
from the N.E. and pleasant
saw plenty of Whales got
one

Long By Ar 172, 40 W

Sunday 25th of October 1840
All this Day Light breezes from
the N.E. and pleasant weather
all hands Boiling and stowing
down - saw plenty of Whales
but did not want them

Lat By Ar 33, 30 S

Long By Ar 172, 50 W

Monday 26th of October 1840
Throughout this Day fresh breezes
from the N. and cloudy weather
saw 4 Whales lowered twice got
one Took him along side at
9 O'clock P.M. took in sail
finish Drying
