

Ship, Brian of Green Port I mean
Tuesday 27th of October 1840
First part of this Day Light breezes
from the N.W. and Rainy kind
of Weather foggy on all hands
Stowing down Latter part more
moderate but in the Whale
Started Day works. at 1 o'clock
heading North

Wednesday 28th of October
First part of this Day Light breezes
from the W. and pleasant Weather
Steering N.W. saw two ships but
no Whale Latter part rainy Weather
Look in sail at 1 o'clock. The watch
Employed Boyling. Lat by Obs 33.50 S
Long by Chron 172.33 W

Thursday 29th of October
First part of this Day Light
breezes from the N.W. and pleasant
Weather at 10 o'clock finish Daying
Saw 2 Sails. Latter part fresh
breezes Look in fly jib and Luff gall
Sails all hands Churning Butter
at 12 past 8 Look in sail heading N.W.
Saw no Whale
Lat by Obs 33.36 S
Long by Chron 172.11 W

Friday 30th of October 1840
All this Day fresh Gale from
the S. and Clear Weather Offshore
Employed Stowing down Saw 2
Ships, no Whale First part heading
E.S.E. Latter N.W. under S.A.M.
Lat by Obs 32.50 S
Long by Chron 171.50 W

Master Running in the S.D. Oct 31st
Saturday 31st of October 1840
First part of this Day Light breezes
from the S. steering on the wind
N.W. Latter part fresh breezes from
the same way Saw no Whale and
Two Ships. Steering the same way
at sunset 1 o'clock Lat by Obs 32.35
Long by Chron 172.19 W

Sunday first of November 1840
First part of this Day Light breezes from
the S.E. heading S.W. pleasant Weather
saw one Ship to the Sward and a
School of Black fish Latter part
wind more to the E heading S
Saw no Whale. at sunset Look in
Jib sail and fly jib. Lat by Obs 33.00
Long by Chron 173.30 W
by Lunar 173.27 W

Monday 2nd of November 1840
Throughout this Day Light breezes
from the S.W. and pleasant
Weather Steering on the wind
S.E. saw 2 Pin Back and 3 Ships
At 1 o'clock P.M. Look in sail
Lat by Obs 33.17 S
Long by Chron 173.20 W

Tuesday 3rd of November 1840
First part of this Day Light breezes
from the N.W. Steering E. saw
3 Ships steering S. and S.E. Latter
part fresh Gale and Squally
saw one Pin Back.
At 11 past 6 P.M. Look in sail
Close Reft the No 2's Light too
heading N.W.
Lat by Obs 34.24 S
Long by Chron 172.28 W
