

Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> of Nov 1840  
 First part of this Day fresh breezes from the N.E. steering on the wind E.S.E. Cloudy weather  
 Latter part heavy gales and raining  
 Took in sail wore ship heading N.W. at 8 o'clock P.M. took in the Fore-sail &c. O.K.M.D. Lat by Obs 34.50  
 one sail in sight, no whale Long by Chron 168.00

Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> of November 1840  
 First and Middle part of this Day heavy gales from the N.E. and raining  
 Weather laying to under O.K.M.D. &c.  
 Heading N.W. by S. Latter part more moderate and partly clear weather  
 Saw nothing at all. Lat by Obs 34.55, S  
 Long by Chron 168.00

Friday 20<sup>th</sup> of November 1840  
 First part of this Day light breezes from the S.W. steering N.W.E. rainy foggy weather. Latter part light breezes and pleasant weather  
 Saw 5 or 6 whales got one but him in starter byworks  
 Took in sail heading E.S.E.  
 Lat by Obs 34.38 S  
 Long by Chron 169.40

Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> of November 1840  
 First part of this Day calm and pleasant weather. Sail in S.W. &c.  
 Latter part a very light breeze from the S.E. steering on the wind E.N.E. Saw 2 or 3 Caribbees. At 3 o'clock P.M. took in sail heading E.S.E.  
 Lat by Obs 34.32 South  
 Long by Chronometer 168.38  
 West

Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> of Nov 1840  
 All this Day fresh breezes from the S.S.E. steering on the wind &c.  
 Thick Cloudy weather and foggy  
 Saw one Curkie and 1 ship the Reptone Jay Harbor. All hands stirring down on the main watch the Reptone &c.  
 2 whale since we saw her last  
 At 7 o'clock took in sail heading S.W.  
 No Obs this Day

Monday 23<sup>d</sup> of Nov 1840  
 All this Day fresh breezes from the S and rugged weather steering E.S.E. under O.K.D. saw 3 ships.  
 Lat by Obs 34.10 S  
 Long by Chron 169.48

Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> of Nov 1840  
 All this Day fresh breeze from the S.W. steering S.E. thick Cloudy thick squally weather & ships in sight spoke the Reptone & Harbor  
 Lat by Obs 34.12  
 No Longitude

Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> of Nov 1840  
 All this Day strong gales from the N.W. heading S under O.K.M.D.  
 Cloudy squally weather Saw one whale  
 Lat by Obs 35.30 S  
 Long by Chron 169.13

Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> of Nov 1840  
 All this Day light breezes from the N. and pleasant weather. Saw 6 or 8 whale struck 2 drew from them both saw 4 ships one cutting.  
 Lat by Obs 36.08 South  
 Long by Chron 169.48 West
