weather Laying under O R M 113
first part heading E Latter W
Barometer Down to 29. and 210...

Tuesday 8th of December 1840
First part of this Day fresh Gale from
the N wore ship heading N, Clear weather
Middle part more moderate made
sail Latter part light breezes more
to the N Ducked ship heading W
at sun set took in sail saw nothing

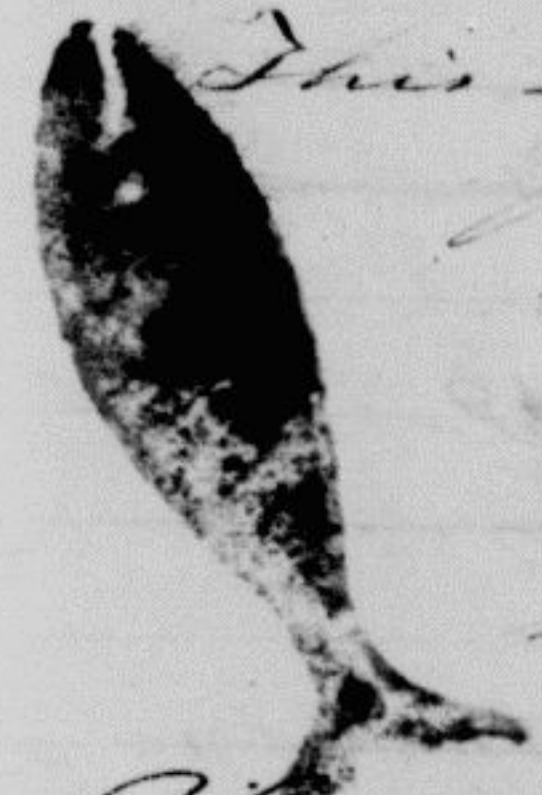

Wednesday 9th of December 1840
All this Day Light breezes from
the W S W Steering S S W pleasant
weather saw one Whale struck
and drew him in

Thursday 10th of December 1840
All this Day Light breeze from the
W and pleasant weather saw one whale
lowered for him saw him no more saw
2 ships spoke one the (Harris) Peruvian
look in S heading S S W

All this Day Light breezes and
Pleasant weather saw
2 Whale got one Put him in
one ship in sight by day

Saturday 12th of December 1840
This Day Commences with fresh breezes
from the SE. Steering S W
two ships in sight saw 2 or 3
Whale got one took him
along side took in sail for
the night

Sunday 13th of December 1840
This Day Commences with fresh breezes
from the S and Cloudy, Put in the
Whale &c. Middle and Latter more moderate
made sail Steering S E. saw 2 ships
and 2 whale spoke the Peruvian
nothing since we saw her last

Monday 14th of December 1840
All this Day Light breezes from
the W and pleasant weather spoke
the Thomas Dickerson bound home full
saw one or two Whale but going very
fast SE did not lower the watch imph
looking &c.

Tuesday 15th of December 1840
All this Day Light breeze from the
S Steering S E the wind W S W saw
2 Whale lowered and Christ got nothing
1 ship in sight
