All this Day light breezes from
the W. steering E by N. pleasant weather
saw plenty of Porpoise and Cramp
Lat by Obs 45 02 S
Long by Obs 126 00 W

Weather steering E by N. latter part
very heavy Gale and rainy at 8 P.M.

and thick weather from the W.

the Main topsail

Barometer down to 29.40 Long by Obs 132 04 W

Wednesday 6th of January 1841
This Day Commences with very heavy
Gale from the W. S. W. at midnight took in
all sail drift too reaching S. E. at Day
Light Made O. R. & kept off E by S
latter part of the Day more moderate
Made more sail at 8 P. M. but Soladings
