 Thursday 21st of January 1841
 First part of this Day light breeze
 from the S.E. and pleasant weather
 steering N. Later part fresh breeze

Friday 22nd of January 1841
 First part of this Day light breeze
 from the S.E. and pleasant weather
 Saw several Fin backs Later fresh
 breeze and pleasant from the E.N.E.
 steering by the wind N. At 4 o'clock

 N.E. very fast. Sailed after him
 until 6 o'clock. Then took in sail
 Dashed ship heading S.E.

 All this Day light breeze from
 the N. steering on the wind N.W.
 at 4 o'clock P.M. saw a Wright whale
 lowered and hoisted but he was going to fast

 At 10 o'clock D.R. the Dashed ship
 heading E by N.
