Saw 3 Whales Struck and
killed one Took him along
Side at 7 o'clock P M

Took in Sail for the night

the E and pleasant weather
Stowed down the Oil one Ship
in Sight Saw 2 Fin Backs,
W M etc.

All this Day vary Light breezes
from the E and calm first
part heading S Latter part N
Saw one Fin Back etc in the

Monday 8th of February 1841

First part of this Day Light
breezes from the N and pleasant
weather Steady W M M at noon
Ducked Ship heading E N E, Saw
one Fin Back Latter part thick
foggy weather Took in Sail

Long by Obs 43.16 W

Tuesday 9th of February 1841

First part of this Day fresh Gales from
the N Steering W M M rainy squally
weather Middle part heavy Gales
took in Sail at 2 o'clock wind
from the S E R M M Took in
the Fore Sail etc Clear weather.

Wednesday 10th of February

All this Day fresh breezes from
the S M Steering S E. Saw two
Fin Backs etc.

French Ship Steering to the N
