

Remarks On Board Ship Trident Wednesday February 10th 1847

Commenced with light
battering winds from NW steering SW by N. Middle part
Moderate breezes from the steering by the wind to SE latter
part light rain & calms. Seem as in midday off Cape Horn
Long by Lunar 66 57 Lat 56° 23'

Thursday Feb 11th Long 66 40

Commenced with light breezes from
the steering by the wind to the SE at 6 o'clock
Saw double Pt. Fr. & M. on the horizon. Next ship
to the Westward Middle part fresh squalls from the
latter part light breezes from South Lat 56° 47'
Long 66° 12'

Friday Feb 12th

Commenced with moderate breezes from
W. & W. steering by the wind to SW. The steering
rather at 9 o'clock. Middle part all hands to shorten
sail. Being a heavy squall from the Middle & latter
part fresh breezes from SW. Saw two ships & one
brig steering to the Eastward & south Lat 56° 55'
Long 66° 19'

Saturday Feb 13th

Commenced with moderate breezes
from SW steering by the wind to Westward
at 9 o'clock. Next ship to the SE. Saw small
Islands bearing W. & S. W. distant 10 days.
Behind the phenomenon of the steering Middle
part moderate breezes from SW. steering SW
Lat 57° 25' Long 68° 22' West

Sunday Feb 14th

Commenced with moderate breezes from
SW steering SW by N. Employed firing together
Middle part small breezes from SW latter part fresh
breezes from the same. Heaped the topsails & set
Lat 57° 40' Long 71° 4'

Monday Feb 15th Commenced with fresh breezes from SW
steering SW by N. Saw a Brig steering to the E. also a
ship to windward steering to the Westward.

Middle & latter parts fresh breezes from NW steering NW
Heavy squalls of wind with rain making taking in sail
Lat 57° 45' Long 74° 25'

Tuesday February 16th

Commenced with strong winds from
NW by N. Heading to the SE at 6 o'clock. Middle part
all hands to the topsails, appearance of a gale. With plenty of rain. The
Middle & latter parts fresh breezes from SW. Saw ship to the
West at 11 AM. So ends this day. Lat 58° 28' Long 75° 05' W

Wednesday Feb 17th

Commenced with fresh breezes from NW
steering NW by N. Saw merchant Brig. Steady to get
to the Westward Middle & latter parts strong breezes from the
SW. steering by the wind to SW. So ends this day. Lat 58° 26' Long 75° 30' W

Thursday Feb 18th

Commenced with strong breezes from NW
Saw ship to the SE by the in company with an American
Brig. Middle & latter parts strong breezes from the
from SW. Heading to SW. Lat 58° 18' Long 77° 00'

Friday Feb 19th

Commenced with fresh gales from
NW heading to the SE. Middle part double Pt. Fr.
Saw close. Middle part topsail & spence & de -
Middle part wind hauled to SW. Saw ship to the West
ward. Latter part moderate breeze sail & so ends. Lat 57° 22' Long 77° 22'

Saturday Feb 20th

Commenced with moderate breezes
from SW steering by the wind to SW. Under all
this wind coming to the Westward. Middle part calm
latter part fresh breezes from SW steering West
After more a favourable breeze. So ends our 20 days
since which we left us to our destined port. Lat 58° 30' Long 78° 20'
