Remains on board Ship Incident.

Wednesday June 7th Commenced with light
barges from the South and thick
foggy weather. Latter part sped and gained with the
Ship. Lament for the thick sailing weather.

Thursday June 8th
Commenced with moderate winds
from the S. at 5 PM. Landed for a while without
success. Took in sail at dusk. Middle and latter
part light barges from the N. saw Finches
also the servant to cross this day.

Saturday June 10th
all this day light barges and
sailing weather. Landed for two whales giving quick
also for a sulphur bottom but no success. Took in
and made all sail at sunset and day light
saw a sail steering to the S. so cross this day.

Sunday June 11th Commenced with fine fresh
barges from the N. and fair
weather. Steering to the N.W. at 1 PM. at the watch
saw the land 15 leagues distant. Saw the ship back
to cross this day.

Wednesday June 14th
Commenced with fresh barges from
the N.W. and fair weather. Landed for two whales and made
all sail. At 1 PM. Landed for a gain of small whales
4 back on Spm. I lost. I saw which the next day at
1 PM. Landed for a right whale without success.
Also the latter part of this day. Sent the whalers and
got the anchors off the bows.

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The Old Incident on the Coast of Greenland

Thursday June 15th Light barges from the S. and
the first of these 24 sails at
at 10 O'clock. PM. kept anchor in the bay of
Petrofushki. Latter part employed getting off wood
to cross. At anchor.

Friday June 16th Light barges from the N.W.
first of this day got off 11
beat land of the Rushmore and at 2 O'clock
PM. kept anchor and had them good night.
Latter part employed showing the anchors and then
to cross. At 5.30 by candle.

Saturday June 17th Commenced with light wind
from the N.W. and fair weather.
Steering to the S. at 3 PM. Landed for a gain of
whales and struck three. I started for here's low
boats. Landed but got stuck in fastening the others
we stranded and got out with a bad pain. Took in the
steer but could not get another on. Then came better fast.
struck a large whale which went to the wind were
with the board two boats fast to it. so end of this.

Sunday June 18th
Light barges from the N.W. all
this day working the O. to the windward. after the
boats. at 4 PM. Landed came a board with no
whale. Capt. I got the head cut some meat. Taken and
made sail. At sunset and day light. Latter part
chased sulphur bottoms and that is all for we night
as well chase the wind. So ends this day.
