Remarks On Board Thursday Nov^r 7

All these 24 hours strong breeze from the South and rain ship heading ESE under double reefed top sails ~~no ship this day~~

Friday Nov^r 8

These 24 hours commences with strong breeze from the South and squally with thunder & lightning took in all sail

Saturday Nov^r 9

The first part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the S W and squally ship heading SSE last part more moderate made some sail

Lat 33° 46' N
Long 29° 55' W

Sunday Nov^r 10

These 24 hours commences with strong breeze from the S W and squally ship heading SSE last part light breeze made all sail

Lat 32° 30' N
Long 37° 22' W

Monday Nov^r 11

These 24 hours commences with light breeze from the S W and good weather saw a ship steering NWSE midle and last part light breeze from the West ship steering South

Lat 31° 16' N
Long 26° 11' West

Tuesday Nov^r 12

Commences with light breeze from the West and good weather with a large swell running South last part calm

Lat 30° 40' N
Long 26° 05' W
