Commences with brisk breeze from the SSE ship steering
by heading SSW saw hump backs
middle and last parts much the same
Lat 25° 4' South
Long 20° 53'

Commences with brisk breeze from the SSE heading SSW
middle and last parts the same saw
a ship steering NW under all sail
Lat 4° 50'
Long 23° 04'

Monday Dec 23
Commences with strong trades at SE by S
ship heading SSW by S middle and
last parts much the same
Lat 13° 00'
Long 26° 28'

Tuesday Dec 24
Commences with strong trades with squalls ship steering
SSW middle and last parts the same
Lat 16° 07'
Long 26° 55'

Wednesday Dec 25
Commences with strong trades at SSE ship steering SSW by S
middle and last parts squally
Lat 18° 25'
Long 27° 45'

Thursday Dec 26
Commences with strong trades at SE ship steering SSW
middle and last parts the same saw
a big steering SE by S found by Lunar
the Chronometer 45 miles to far Lat 20° 00'
Long 29° 01'
