

Saturday March 5<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales from the NNE with some  
rain ship heading SW

Sunday March 6<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales from the NE and  
raining ship heading SW under  
close reefed top sails at 6 PM sounded  
40 fathoms no bottom wore ship  
to the Eward

Monday March 7<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales  
from the NNE and some rain  
ship heading SW under close reefed  
top sails Lat 28.54  
Long 123.20

Tuesday March 8<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales from the NE and  
overcast at 2 PM came to anchor  
at the Tai Chau Islands in 9 fathoms  
water muddy bottom

Thursday March 10<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales from the N to NE and the  
last part raining employed breaking out  
the fore hold to top the ship and  
striking off some copper on the bows  
to find the leak had one gunk  
come off to the ship and wanted to  
come on board but were not  
allowed

Thursday March 11<sup>th</sup>  
Strong breezes from the NE and  
stormy weather employed searching for  
the leak several boats came off to the  
ship but were not anxious to trade

Friday March 12<sup>th</sup>  
Strong breezes from  
the NE and raining weather not fit  
to work

Saturday March 13<sup>th</sup>  
Strong breezes from the NE and  
overcast employed repairing ship

Sunday March 14<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales from the NE and  
raining employed filling ground tier  
and putting in copper on the bows

Monday March 15<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales from the NE with passing  
clouds finished repairing and stowing of  
the hold and got the ship ready for  
sea

Tuesday March 16<sup>th</sup>  
First part light winds from the North and  
fine weather got under way at 8 AM  
and left Tai Chau Islands last part wind  
veered to NNE and heavy saw a big  
staring South

Wednesday March 17<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gales from the North and clear  
weather saw 2 ships Lat 28.18  
Long 123.37

Thursday March 18<sup>th</sup>  
Light winds from the NNE and fine  
weather ship heading SW middle part calm  
last part light winds from the South ship  
staring NE by E employed repairing main  
sail & bent new main spencer  
Lat 28.40  
Long 123.02
