

May 31 saw 2 bow heads the first ones
spoke the ship Eric & back Friends
saw nine ships got a pipe of bread
from the Eric 350 gallons and agreed
to return the same quantity at the
sandwich Islands Lat 57. 50
Long 150. 17

Wednesday June 2
The first part light winds from the E
and foggy 7 ships in sight saw one
whale struck him and deared
carried sail to the S.E. Lat about
57. 40
Long 150. 30

Monday June 7 The first part light
winds from the South and foggy last
part strong breeze from the S.E. and
less fog Spoke the Marie Theresa and
Isaac Howland got two casks of bread
from the Marie Theresa Lat 58. 02
Long about 142. 40

Wednesday June 9
Jonas Island bearing E.S.E distant
20 miles saw plenty whales got one
saw the Isaac Howland got one

Got 6 whales in June which made
about 800 blb saw them very plenty
with a good deal of good weather
but rather hard to strike have
drawn from several and parted
from one have seen them plenty all
the way from Jonas Island to the Lat.
of 58. 30 and about the Long of Cape
Elizabeth

The last days of June and July
up to the present which is the
8th the weather has been thick with
some rain yesterday got one whale
saw another ship got one several
other ships in sight whaling but
the most of the day foggy supposed
Lat 58. 20 Long about the same as above

Came to anchor in Castle Bay
July 22 got a whale the 23rd
and saw them quite plenty saw
a number the 24th but got none

August run down into the Gulf
about the middle saw plenty of whales
got one six other ships were doing
about the same chased there about
ten days had a gale of wind from
the West and stood off shore went
in Lat of Jonas Island but saw nothing

Sept 4 left Cape Elizabeth with
a gale from the W.S.W. steering
S.E. saw the Marie Theresa

Sept 19 passed Marian Island
and put away for the Sandwich
Islands
