

Oct. 19th 1852

Came to anchor off Coker

Nov. 30th 1852

Unmoored ship and went out of the harbour

Dec. 26th 1852

landed at Hervey's Island and shot a bear on shore

Dec. 28th

landed at Mungee bought some things from the wreck of ship Francis and took eight of her crew as passengers

Jan. 11th made Research's Island

Jan. 17th 1853 came to anchor in Mangama

Harbour New Zealand

Feb. 3rd left Mangama with the wind S.E.

March 20th

arrived at The King's Hill Islands have to off Simpson's Island and the natives came on board

April 23rd made the land about Oaderha straits saw some whales called some of them right whales

April 26th passed through Oaderha straits into Ocher's sea

April 28th 1853

Lat 49.00 N. Long 152.50 East
Saw ice much broken and scattered

May 10th

Lat 54.00 N. Long 149.00 W. saw one ship and one Barque saw a good deal of ice and quite heavy but scattered about in small patches and single pieces the patches trailing from windward to leeward the wind N.E. the wind having been from N. and several days perhaps in the course of the ice lying in that shape ship steering by the wind under easy sail this night on account of ice

May 12th brisk breeze from the N.E. with snow squalls ship standing to N.E. in company with the Canada saw a bear ahead going quick West lowered for him

Lat 55.00 N.
Long 152.00 W.

May 16th light breeze from the N. ward varying from N.W. to N.E. being a continuation of the same weather for the last four days with light flurries of snow. this day saw 2 whales besides several ships boats chasing struck one with the gun and the line parted saw 2 ships get a whale each Lat 55.18 Long by Chron 151.02 suppose the Chronometer about one degree to far East
