

Tuesday May 17th

Light breeze and clear weather
wind from West some whals about but not
very plenty got one saw 2 other ships got one
nearly 20 ships in sight and most all
chasing whales no obs this day
ice very plenty

Tuesday May 31st

light breeze and fine weather
employed bailing several ships in
sight saw no whales until late in
the afternoon have taken four whales
and are now boiling the last of them
have been about among the ice the
last three weeks have seen whales
plenty a few times the rest of the
time very scattering

Lat this day 57.55 Long 150.30

Cape Clinin in sight bearing N.E.
Dist. 50 miles

June 8th Lat 57.25 Long about 150.00
saw plenty whales for two or three days
got one the first and here the third of
this month the whales seem to keep
near the ice have seen about a half
doz ships about here this day quite
foggy

June 20th the first part foggy last
part clear made Janas Island found the
Eight day Chronometer within about three miles
of being correct saw hump backs and a few
ships all hands scraping bone

Janas Island

June 22nd got a whale got another the 25th
got them near the ice in Lat 55.30
Long 142.00 saw but very few whales
afterwards about there saw the Isaac Howland
with 15 whales the John Howland with
5 whales Robin Hood with 3 whales
Follows with 4 the Three Brothers
with 8 the Phoenix with 10 our selfs
with 10 which made 1134 blb

August 6th Come to anchor to the SW of
of Hazard Bay saw whales quite plenty
but could not strike them

August 8th got under way and
went into Hazard Bay and anchored
near the Barge Antelope saw whales
very plenty and of all sizes

August 9th killed a whale and he was
10th struck one and his time parted
11th got one and took him along side
while doing that the other drifted past
and we picked him up

August 13th got under way and ran
up the Bay for more shelter in company
with the Antelope come to in 7 fathoms
water mated this day with the
Antelope agreed to divide losses and
gains equally

September 5th saw the Barge Endeavor
hailing between fourteen and fifteen hundred
barrels and say they want three hundred
more to fill their casks
