

Sept 9 1853

left Clementien Bay for Sandwich Islands and
home with a full ship, leaving the Banks
Antelope ~~Endeavour~~ ^{with} 16 or 17 lbs
Endeavour wanting 300 to fill their casks
Fortune with about 1200 lbs. Hellipoint
1400 lbs. General Williams
wanting about 200 lbs. Mechanic 200 lbs.

Sept 12

fine weather light winds from
S. by E. steering East at sundown Cape Elizabeth
bearing 2 1/2 distant 12 miles

Sept 20th left for Marika Island
in a ~~fine~~ fog steering S.E. at 3 P.M.
steering East strong gale from W by W

October 20th went into Oahu Harbour
and moored ship.

Nov 22 took the anchors and went
to sea from Waikoo Harbour

Dec 20th Made Whytotucke
got some wood and vegetables
left Charles Inmann there sick
properly provided for

Dec 23 went on shore at Rorotongo
stayed a short time and came on board
again and kept away S.E. by S with
light breezes from S.W.

January 29th 1854

Passed Cape Horn in Lat. 57. 15
with light winds varying from W to E
and some fog. saw several ships

March 22nd 1854
Cape St. Augustin in sight

April 20th got soundings in 64 fathoms
