

May 16th 188
passed through the Fox Islands into the
Kantohaka Sea in Long 120.10

May 17th put the starboard low boat in
the crane

June 18th arrived off Flower Bay in company
with ten or twelve ships natives came
on board

June 20th run into Bherings straits
as far as messiaha Bay could get no
farther for ice and were obliged to work
back up to this time we have not
seen any whales

July 2^d passed East Cape and went
into the Arctic Ocean

July 6th Lat 40.00 Long 168.40 W

July 7th saw a few bowheads saw the
Starah Shee cutting one Cape Lisburne
bearing SSW dist. 40 miles

July 28th went into St Lawrence bay
to get water

July 30th passed East Cape into the Arctic Ocean

Aug 6th got the first whale off Cape Lisburne

Sept 4th got the last whale in Arctic Ocean

Sept 10th passed East Cape boreal weather

Sept 14th took wind from Northward which
has continued to the present time (Sept 22) and
most of the time strong gales and thick weather
{ Lat 61.14 Long 178 183 }

Sept 23^d made Gores Island run within 15 miles
then had a cadet tried to catch fish but
could not draw one ship

Sept 24th wind breezed up from S & E
with hazy weather

Oct 23^d went into Honolulu Harbour

Nov 13th got under way and left Honolulu

Dec 4th made Whylodake

Dec 8th left Rorotonga

Dec 20th Lat 40.41 N Long 162.32 W

Saw a merchantman bark painted black
steering East
Caught two porpoises

Dec 24th Lat 45.23 Long 161.00 strong breezes from
North saw a right whale going to the
windward did not lower

Dec 26th Strong breezes from North and foggy saw a ship

Dec 26th Wind from NW and fine weather
at daylight saw two whales
the low boat went on and missed
Lat 45.30 Long 161.00

Dec 28th Saw 5 whales lowered without success
saw the ship Dover had picked up one whale
Lat 45.30 Long 160.23

Dec 30th Saw 3 whales lowered without success
rough weather
Lat 45.20 Long 160.58
