Moderate breeze from S & S by E strong
breeze from S by E took in all light sails
to double reefed latter part showing
a gale from W by N blowing under storm
sails headed to the S

breeze from S by E was to the S by E

Light breeze from S by E course S by E

soundings in 14 fathoms dark sand
middle light breeze from S by E course S by E
latter part squally

Sunday March 11

Moderate gale from S by E with squalls of
wind course S by E middle moderate breeze
from S by E made all sail course S by E
latter part calm got soundings in 14
fathoms dark sand

Monday March 12

Light airs and calms. Middle light breeze from
S by E course S by E latter part fresh breeze
from W by N S by E under all sail

Tuesday March 13

Fresh breeze from W with cloudy weather
course S by E 4 P.M. showed S by E 9 P.M.
moderate breeze from S by E with fine
weather took in the light sails and double
reefed the fore and main top sails
set to make water land bearing S by E 9
dist 5 leagues latter part moderate gale
from S by E course S by E under close reefed
top sails and reefed courses 11 P.M. 12 P.M.
at 1 P.M. bore S by E by compass dist 8 leagues

Long 16.20 W

Wednesday March 14

Moderate breeze from W by N 4 P.M.
Saw a squally look in to storm sails middle
Ship moderate gale from W by N showed S
latter part strong breeze made some
sail wind W by N over S by E

Lat 54.56 S

Long 14.56 W

Thursday March 15

First part showed on to gale from
the Westward called all hands and hoisted
the ship to under storm sails middle
part showed a young hurricane from
the S by E ship heading S by E latter part
moderate gale from S by E was to the Westward
