Sunday April 15 P.M.
3 P.M. sent two boats in to Cumberland
harbour to try the market and get the news
7 P.M. the boats returned latter part got some
Beavers and quines

Monday April 16
Got some fish and a one horned Billy
goat 9 P.M. took up the boats and steered
to the N. by W. bound to St. Felix latter part
getting ready to put out a starboard
chase boat

Lat 32.11 S

Tuesday April 17
3 P.M. saw Whales to the S. of St. Felix
gallied them with the Ship lowered 4
boats got none of course latter part made
St. Felix

Friday April 20
3 P.M. gallied a school of 40 tall Whales
with the Ship again lowered for them
got none of course 7 P.M. spoke Barge
Montgomery Crope 21 months out
hauling 500 spin dont believe he has
got it - made no stop here but steered
off to the N.

April 21
made a bore Head crossed here
until the 6 of May in sight of the
land saw nothing Employed getting
rigging spoke Bark Catchlot Bay
30 months out - 5:50 P.M.
