

Ship Trident at Callao

Thursday May 17. 1910
7 P.M. Anchored off Callao in 8 fathoms water here we shifted sails tarred rigging painted floors and hull out side and in watered and recruited ship and gave the men 4 days liberty a watch sold 38 lbs of oil 7 men deserted

June 1
Got underway and went to search for the Capt and family on shore June 15 went in to Callao in the afternoon Capt came on board with two of the doctors and 9 men shipped here went to sea in the evening

June 4
From this time until the 13 of July we cruised from Lat 13.00 South to 18.12 South in sight of the land most of the time saw no sperm whales had strong winds and cold rugged weather

July 18
Sent a boat in to Pisco for letters but found none

July 19
Sent a boat in to the Chincha Islands

July 20
4 of our men and one entertaining young boatsteward attempted to steal a boat and run we found it out in time to stop it

July 22
At night anchored off Callao in 17 fathoms water wide out

July 23
8 A.M. Capt & left the ship for the city with Lucas as near to my wife as he is to his at sunset we all man the guard arm in to the batt to keep the sailors from running we laid here until the 24 got some water and potatoes put on board store and on Pailar ashore and had a glorious time over all round

July 24
5 P.M. Capt & Band Lady came off got underway and went to sea steered off bound to the Line and Gallapagos Islands

August 14 Sat. 10.12.9
Spoke Barken Bay Lapseth Bay 44 months out 1000 Mm Exchange in boatsteward and a Goat for a Cook with the S.

August 17 Sat. 10.12.9
Spoke Barken Aurora Marshall 44 months out 18 Mm

August 24
Made Woods Island cruised to the South of Woods & Charles Island until the 31 of August and then started for the Callao ground
