Arrived on the Callao ground found
no Whales and a plenty of mixed weather

Spoke Bark President - 18 months
12.30 pm and Henry Taka - 12 months
12.45 pm

Long 79.46 West

Oct 31
Spoke Bark Valparaiso - 49 months
12.30 pm & Bark Courier - 49 months
12.45 pm

Lat 14.45 S
Long 79.40 W

Nov 19
Spoke Ship Archer - 49 months
12.00 pm

Lat 14.41 S

Nov 27
Saw a lone Whale and got him -
the first Whale that we have taken
for 9 months Spoke Bark Allen
24 months 4.00 pm

Dec 4
Spoke Bark Clara Bell - 18 months
Lat 15.25 S
Long 79.49 W

Dec 13
J. P. M. saw a school of the whales
sawed for them but did not see
them out of the boats

Lat 15.33 S
Long 79.59 W

Dec 14 1860
J. P. M. saw a lone Whale coming to windward
got out the boat down and struck him
within 300 yds of the Ship & P. M. took him
to the Ship

Friday Dec 21
Spoke Ship Com. Morris - 17 months
2.45 pm

Lat 14.30 S

January 15 1861
Sent a boat in to the Chincha Islands
for letters

Jan 17
Sent a boat in to the Chincha Islands to leave
letters

Jan 26
Anchored in Callao harbor painted
Ship out side got water recruited gave
4 days liberty and 2 men
and have discharge for 2 men
Donovan and Phipps gave 2 men
in his place Phipps 10 men

Feb 16
Got underway and went to sea and
left the Capt ashore

Feb 17
Went in to Callao and stood off and on
until night then came to in 17 fathoms
