

February 15

At 4 P.M. got all on board and stood out-bound on a cruise steered off N.W. until the 20th of February and then in Lat 12.00 South Long 86.50 West saw a large body of Whales and took a large one and a small one

February 23

Light breeze and fine weather saw a school of Whales and secured 4 boats and galled them as fast as we could
Lat 11.26 South
Long 86.07 West

March 13

Saw a school of Whales so late to do any thing secured 4 boats got nothing
Lat 12.00 South

March 14

Saw several schools of 10-15 Whales and caught 4

March 22

Saw Whales in co with Barkis Grey Hound & Lorange secured from all three ships but got nothing

Lat 12.00 S
Long 86.04 W

April 6

Spoke Barque Mary and Susan and steered off N.W. in co

April 11

Partean company with the Mary & Susan
Lat 10.10 South
Long 90.27 West

At the Gallapagos Islands

April 17 1841

Spoke Hood Island having come from the Galapagos ground in 4 days had strong trade and nothing coming down

April 18

Anchored in convey Bay Porter Island in 10 fathoms water saw and secured 100 lbs of Seal here until the 25 got 10 boat loads of wood off Porter Island and and 154 small Terra pin off Duncan Island 40 of these from the death after we got to sea

April 26

Got underway and worked out to the South

April 27

Took 200 lbs of Seal 19 miles to the North of Porter Island had a chance to get two cruised all round the Islands to windward and and secured several Flips none of them had home anything lately

June 7

Saw Whales between Caliper and Menmans Island secured one and drove the school off

June 9

Saw Whales and took two

July 1

Anchored off Isamar in 6 fathoms water got 400 lbs of water and fruit in a bundle saw the Steam Boat Fleet at anchor to seaward then bought 12 chords of good wood here at 1/2 per chord
July 10 got underway and went to sea
