Good weather to day. we got at 5 and carting Turnips from uncle John's we had 30 bushels he had 60 cut up wood in the afternoon.

A hard storm it will do for the line yard. I am in the house can't do much for day.

22

Good weather at work at Uncle John's making pens.

23

At work at Uncle John's on fence for the Turnips.

APRIL FOOL DAY

April 1

Carted manure out of the Hay pen 11 loads and 3 from the barnyard put it on the onion patch piece. It has been cold and blustering the most for of the day and looks like a storm to night.

2. Sunday

A hard snow storm it has snowed all day and it as much as 3 inches deep none of us have been to meeting it has cleared up to night.

3 Monday

The snow this morning would have it froze hard last night but it has been warm to day the snow has most all left but it does not look like planting onions.

4 Tuesday

The Surveyors have been up the road to day surveyed the road down through the woods.

5 Wednesday

The surveyors have surveyed the road up this way through the spruce so we have two roads surveyed on the place.

6 Thursday

went to meeting this morning it is fast day and went heaving to night got 15.

Friday April 7

Plowed the onion patch and planted 30 Rod

Saturday 8

Finished planting the onions and planted some small stuff. Plowed the north bottom in skunk hollow.

Monday 10

Planted the potatoes in the North hollow down in skunk hollow plantation.

Wednesday 12

Carted manure in the barley field. She fed her cows with 10 chickens from under the hog house.

Thursday 13

Plowed the barley field and set 3 hens.

Friday 14

dowed the grain and went heaving in the afternoon and did not see a heaver. set out the seed things Onions Beets Turnips Carrot and cabbage.

Saturday 15

Plowed 2 of a row down in skunk hollow and planted some peas.

Monday 17

Been at work at Uncle John's planting potatoes.

Tuesday 18

went down to Henry Jenkins in the trap after Shingles and barbed 1 load of seed for David and got a bowl of Lard.

Wednesday 19

Plowed the bean patch and Barrowed the turnip patch.

Saturday 22

Commenced planting the white apple potatoes.
