

Bound to the Indian Ocean 1838.

- Thursday Nov. 1st. Steering on different tacks by the wind a number of sail in sight. Lat. 5° 54' S. - Long. 17° 03' W.
- Friday Nov. 2nd. First part equally attended with Showers of rain, Middle part pleasant, latter part thick and rainy, Steering on different tacks by the wind in company with several sail. Lat. 4° 52' S. - Long. 17° 23' W.
- Saturday Nov. 3rd. Commences with brisk winds from the S. by W. attended with squalls of rain, at 2 P.M. took in the Royals and Flying Jib at 1/2 past Do. tacked to the westward, Middle and latter part Cloudy so ends several sail in sight. Lat. 4° 20' S. - Long. 16° 59' W.
- Sunday Nov. 4th. Commences with winds from the S. and Cloudy attended with light squalls of rain Steering to the westward by the wind all sail set, at 4 P.M. took in the Royals and Flying Jib, Middle and latter part fresh Gales and overcast. so ends. Lat. 3° 13' S. - Long. 18° 00' W.
- Monday Nov. 5th. All these 24 hours fresh Breezes from the S. and Cloudy Steering to the westward by the wind. Lat. 2° 12' S. - Long. 19° 19' W.
- Tuesday Nov. 6th. First and Middle part Cloudy, latter part clear and pleasant, winds from S. Steering to the westward by the wind. Lat. 1° 15' S. - Long. 20° 38' W.
- Wednesday Nov. 7th. First and Middle part light winds from the S. and fine weather Steering on different tacks by the wind, latter part Brisk winds from the S. S. E. Steering to the S. W. Lat. 0° 32' S. - Long. 21° 04' W.
- Thursday Nov. 8th. All these 24 hours Brisk winds from S. to S. E. by S. Steering to the S. W. by the wind, Middle and latter part Cloudy at 10 am. took in the Royals and Flying Jib. Lat. 1° 02' S. - Long. 21° 53' W.
- Friday Nov. 9th. All these 24 hours Strong winds from the S. S. W. Steering to the S. W. by the wind employed in tacking &c. Lat. 2° 54' 37' S. - Long. 22° 53' W.
- Saturday Nov. 10th. All these 24 hours Strong winds from the S. S. E. Middle part squally latter part pleasant employed in tacking rigging. Lat. 4° 12' S. - Long. 23° 54' W.
- Sunday Nov. 11th. First part light winds attended with light squalls of rain, Middle part heavy squalls and rainy, at midnight

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- took in the P. G. Sails, at 5 am. took the P. G. Sails, latter part Brisk winds from the S. E. and Clear so ends these 24 hours. Lat. 5° 44' S. - Long. 24° 24' W.
- Sunday Nov. 11th. All these 24 hours moderate winds from the S. E. by E. and pleasant at 9 am. saw a shoal of Blackfish, so ends. Lat. 4° 21' S. - Long. 24° 25' W.
- Monday Nov. 12th. All these 24 hours fine Breezes from the S. S. E. Steering to the Southward by the wind all sail set. Lat. 3° 03' S. - Long. 24° 13' W.
- Tuesday Nov. 13th. All these 24 hours Strong Breezes from the S. S. E. and clear Steering to the Southward by the wind, at 8 P.M. took in the Royals, - Lat. 10° 58' S. - Long. 24° 04' W.
- Wednesday Nov. 14th. All these 24 hours Brisk winds from the S. S. E. Steering to the Southward by the wind, at 5 P.M. took in the Main Royal and Flying Jib, Middle part S. S. E. latter part Clear and fine. Lat. 13° 04' S. - Long. 24° 00' W.
- Thursday Nov. 15th. Commences with Brisk winds from the S. E. and Clear Middle part Cloudy, attended with light Squalls of rain latter part overcast. so ends Steering to the Southward by the wind. Lat. 14° 38' S. - Long. 24° 13' W.
- Friday Nov. 16th. All these 24 hours brisk winds from S. S. E. to S. S. W. Steering to the Southward by the wind Middle and latter part squally, attended with light Showers of rain. - so ends. Lat. 16° 45' S. - Long. 24° 18' W.
- Saturday Nov. 17th. First and Middle part Strong winds from the S. E. by E. and Squally, Steering to the Southward by the wind latter part clear at 10 am. saw a Shoal of Blackfish so ends. Lat. 18° 43' S. - Long. 24° 13' W.
- Sunday Nov. 18th. First part Brisk winds from the S. and Clear Steering to the Southward by the wind, middle part Cloudy, latter part Clear and pleasant so ends these 24 hours. Lat. 20° 33' S. - Long. 23° 22' W.
- Monday Nov. 19th. All these 24 hours light winds from the S. by E. and fine weather, Steering to the Southward by the wind employed in painting Boats Rigger Spencers &c. &c. Lat. 21° 54' S. - Long. 22° 19' W.
