 Nov. 20th to E by S. Steering to the Southward by the wind
 Wednesday Lat. 23° 16' S. - - - Long 21° 19' W.
 Nov. 21st Commences with light winds from the E. Steering to the
 Southward by the wind, Middle and latter part brisk
 winds from the N.E. by N. Steering to the S.E. by E. -
 Thursday Lat 24° 13' S. - - - Long. 19° 15' W.
 Nov. 22nd All these 24 hours variable winds from the Northward and
 equally, attended with light showers of rain Steering to the
 S.E. by E. so ends these 24 hours all Sail set. -
 Friday Lat 24° 49' S. - - - Long. 18° 00' W.
 Nov. 23rd All these 24 hours light winds from the Northward and fine
 weather Steering to the S.E. variously employed. -
 Saturday Lat. 25° 26' S. - - - Long. 16° 58' W.
 Nov. 24th All these 24 hours moderate winds from the N.E. and fine
 weather, Steering to the S.E. all Sail set, variously employed
 Sunday Lat. 26° 20' S. - - - Long. 15° 32' W.
 Nov. 25th All these 24 hours brisk winds from the N.E. and Clear,
 Steering to the S.E. by E. all Sail set.
 Monday Lat. 27° 15' S. - - - Long 12° 24' W.
 Nov. 26th All these 24 hours fine breezes from N. to N.E. Steering
 to the S.E. all Sail set variously employed. -
 Tuesday Lat. 28° 23' S. - - - Long 9° 29' W.
 Nov. 27th Commences with winds from the N.E. and Clear Steering
 to the S.E. all Sail set Middle & latter part overcast.
 Wednesday Lat. 29° 21' S. - - - Long. 7° 14' W.
 Nov. 28th All these 24 hours winds from the N.E. and fine
 weather Steering to the S.E. all Sail set.
 Thursday Lat. 30° 08' S. - - - Long. 4° 52' W.
 Nov. 29th Commences with moderate winds from the N.E. and
 fine weather Steering to the S.E. at Middle part Cloudy at
 10 Am. Strong Gales from the W. and squally took in the
 Royals and Studding sails, at 11 To. Double reefed the P. Sails &
 sent Down the Royal yards so ends these 24 hours. Books.
 Friday Lat. 31° 16' S. - - - Long. 2° 14' W.
 Nov. 30th Commences with Strong Gales from the W. by S. Steering
 to the S.E. by S. at 3 Am. took in the Jib, & M. Sail, at 4 took
 in the Waist Boat, so ends these 24 hours.

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Saturday Lat 32° 30' S. - - - Long 0° 43' East.
 Dec. 1st Commences with heavy Gales from the W. by S. Steering to the
 S.E. by E. at 4 P.M. took in the P. & Mizzen P. Sails and Close reefed
 the M. P. Sail, at 4 past 5 Am. set the P. Sails Double reefed, at 6
 set the Jib, at 9 set the M. Sail & Grandee, and let one reef out
 of the P. Sails, so ends a heavy sea running. -
 Sunday Lat. 33° 24' S. - - - Long 3° 09' E.
 Dec. 2nd Commences with brisk winds from the W. S.W. Steering to the
 S.E. by S. all Sail set, at 4 P.M. got out the Waist Boat at 5 Am.
 set the Studding sails so ends Strong breezes and Cloudy
 Monday Lat. 34° 34' S. - - - Long 5° 58' East.
 Dec. 3rd Commences with brisk winds from the W. by S. and Cloudy, Steer-
 ing to the S.E. all Sail set, from 4 to 7 P.M. saw several Right Whales
 at midnight began to take in Sail, at 8 Am. brought the Ship
 to the wind under a close reefed Main P. Sail heading to
 the Southward, took in the Waist Boat, heavy Gales ends the Day
 Tuesday Lat. 35° 17' S. - - - Long 9° 12' E.
 Dec 4th At 6 P.M. set the P. Sail and Steered to the S.E. at 5 Am. set the
 P. Sails Double reefed, and Jib, at 9 To. set the M. Sail, latter
 part strong Gales and a heavy sea running so ends the Day
 Thursday Lat. 35° 48' S. - - - Long 11° 30' E.
 Dec 5th First and Middle part brisk winds from the W. by S. Steer-
 to the S.E. all Sail set, latter part strong Gales and thick
 weather attended with mists of rain, so ends all Sail set. No obs.
 Thursday Lat 36° 00' S. - - - Long. 14° 26' E. -
 Dec. 6th All these 24 hours brisk winds from the W. S.W. and Clear Steer-
 ing to the S.E. by E. all Sail set, the water very green so ends
 Friday Lat. 35° 52' S. - - - Long. 17° 18' E.
 Dec 7th First part Strong breezes and Clear, at midnight took in the
 Studding sails, at 6 Am. took in the P. & Sails, and Double reefed
 the Main Mizzen P. Sails, at 10 took in the Main Sail, and Single
 reefed the M. P. Sail, latter part equally attended with showers of
 rain, winds from W. S.W. Steering S. by S. -
 Saturday Lat. 35° 20' S. by an. - - - Long. 20° 20' E.
 Dec. 8th Commences with Strong winds from the Westward Steering to
 the S.E. by E. at 1 P.M. P. & M. Sails & M. Sail, Middle part Calm, latter
 part strong Breezes from the E and a heavy swell from the
 westward Steering to the Southward by the wind so ends
