Jan. 29th. Ship Porters of New-Bedford Bound to

to the S. E. wore again, at 5 P.M. began to moderate set

Monday
Feb. 1st. Commences with winds from S. and pleasant steering E. 1/2 S.
at Sunset took in the Flying Jib and Mizzen Top gallentail, at 4
P.M. set them again, latter part winds from S. E. so ends

Lat. 26-10 S. - Long. 171-28 W.

Tuesday
Feb. 2nd. This Day brisk winds from the S. E. to E. and fine weather
steering to the N. E. by the wind all sail set.
Lat. 25-13 S. - Long. 170-00 West.

Wednesday
Feb. 3rd. This Day fresh breezes from E. to S. E. steering to the N. E.
by the wind all sail set, at 4 P.M. passed a Ship steering
to the westward, at 6 P.M. saw a Ship ahead sailing
so ends in company, strong winds and Cloudy
Lat. 24-13 S. - Long. 169-06 W.

Thursday
Feb. 4th. Commences with strong Gale from S. E. and equally steering
to the N. E. by the wind, at 2 P.M. spoke the London Packet of
Fair Haven sailing, 15 hrs. out 1000 bbls. at 4 P.M. took in the
Jib and Main Sail, at Sunset took in the Fore & Miz. S. Sail and
Double reefed the main, at 6 P.M. wore Ship and set Double reefs
on with the L. Packet Lat. 23-49 S. - Long. 168-38 West.

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Friday
Jan. 5th. Commences with strong Gale from the S. E. steering to
the N. E. by the wind under Double reefed Top sails, at Sunset
1st part took in the Jib and Spanker, at 6 P.M. sent down the
Top gallentails, and took in the Waist Boat.
Lat. 23-46 S. - Long. 167-53 W.

Saturday
Jan. 6th. Strong Gale from S. E. and Cloudy heading to the N. E.
at 1 P.M. took in the Fore and Mizzen Top sails and Fore Sail,
at 4 P.M. took in the Waist Boat, at 6 P.M. took in the Close
reefed Main Top sail, at 8 P.M. set it again, so ends with strong
Gales. - Lat. 23-50 S. - Long. 167-45 W.

Sunday
Jan. 7th. This Day strong Gale from the S. E. heading to the N. E. first
part Cloudy, latter part clear at 8 A.M. set the Fore Sail and
Fore Top sail Double reefed, and let one reef out of the
Main Top sail, so ends with strong Gale

Monday
Jan. 8th. Commences with strong Gale from the S. E. steering to the
N. E. by the wind under Double reefs, at 4 P.M. set the Jib and
Spanker, at 2 P.M. the Main Sail and Single reefs, latter
part sent up the Main Top gallentail
Lat. 22-23 S. - Long. 168-17 W.

Tuesday
Jan. 9th. All these 24 hours strong Gale from S. E. to E. and overcast,
steering to the N. E. by the wind, at 5 P.M. Double reefed the
Top sails took in the Jib and Main Sail, Middle and latter
part the same Lat. 21-28 S. - Long. 165-21 W.

Wednesday
Jan. 10th. Commences with strong Gale from the E. by S. steering to the
N. E. by the wind, under Double reefs at 6 P.M. wore Ship, Middle
and latter part thick weather with frequent squalls of rain most
of the time Jib and Spanker in, Mr. obs. Lat. by L. R. 21-54 S.

Thursday
Jan. 11th. Commences with strong Gale from the E. and Cloudy steering
to the southward by the wind under Double reefs, latter part
moderate winds and pleasant all sail set so ends with a head
swell on Lat. 22-30 S. - Long. 164-40 West.

Friday
Jan. 12th. Winds from E. to N. E. and equally attended with showers of
rain, steering to the southward by the wind
Lat. 23-42 - - - Long.
