Saturday May 15th. This Day fresh breezes from the Northward and fair employed in Painting, one watch on liberty Sailed Bark *Loose*, Ray on a Cruise

Sunday May 16th. Moderate Winds from S. E. and fair one Watch on liberty

Monday May 17th. Strong breezes from S. E. and fair employed painting the Spars, setting up Shooks &c. one Boats Crew on liberty

Tuesday May 18th. Winds from S. E. and fair employed Painting Spars, filling Water &c one Boats Crew on liberty

Wednesday May 19th. First part Strong breezes from the Northward and equally employed in Painting and taking Water onboard latter part raining one Boats Crew on liberty

Thursday May 20th. Winds from E. to S. E. and equally employed in stowing Water taking Biscuit onshore &c. one Boats Crew on liberty Arrived Ship *Cornithan* of New Bedford 21 ms out 1300 bbls.

Friday May 21st. Strong breezes from E. S. E. and equally variously employed about the Rigging sent down the main Maststay and sent up the New one, one Boats Crew on liberty

Saturday May 22nd. Strong breezes from E. S. E. and equally employed in stowing Wood bending Sails &c. one Boats Crew on liberty

Sunday May 23rd. Strong breezes from S. E. and equally one Boats Crew on liberty

to Anchor at Tahiti 1841

Monday May 24th. Strong breezes from the Eastward and fair employed getting new onboard setting up Shooks &c. one watch on liberty

Tuesday May 25th. Variable winds and equally all hands variously employed at 9 Am. sent 2 Boats of trading for Yams around the other side of the Island Discharged the Cook sick, and Mr. Davis at his own request

Wednesday May 26th. Light variable Winds and fair variously employed

Thursday May 27th. First part variable Winds and raining, latter part Winds from S. W. and fair one watch on liberty at 11 Am. the Boats returned from trading

Friday May 28th. First part moderate winds from the westward and raining latter part brisk winds from S. E. and fair employed in taking water onboard one watch on liberty Sailed Ships *Mary* of Han. and *George Porter* of New Bedford on a Cruise

Saturday May 29th. Variable winds and raining one watch on liberty

Sunday May 30th. First part variable winds and heavy rain latter part fair one watch on liberty

Sunday May 30th. West low time at 7 Am. got underway with light breezes of the Land at 8 P. M. outside the reef Discharged the Pilot latter part calm employed in stowing the anchors and clearing Decks at noon 3 mi S. from the reef of Papetera Harbor

Monday May 31st. Light variable winds and fair stowing on different courses to the westward at noon. Some bore S. 12 mi. S. employed in Painting Boats &c.
