

Ship Triton of New-Bedford

Thursday June 17th. First part strong winds from S. S. E. to S. and raining. Steering on different tack under Double reef Jib and Main Sail in, latter part brisk Winds from S. S. W. and equally steering to the S. E. by the wind all Sail set. Lat. 25=11 S. - Long. 145=40 W.

Friday June 18th. Commenced with strong Gales from S. and equally steering to the S. E. by the wind at 1 P.M. took in the Poppallantsails Middle part Thunder attended with heavy squalls of rain and rain, at Midnight under Double reefed Fore and Main Popsails and Fore Sail at 7 Am the squalls cleared of so ends with strong Gales lying under easy Sail. Lat. 25=27 S. - Long. 145=01 W.

Saturday June 19th. First and Middle part strong Winds from S. W. and equally heading to the S. E. under easy Sail, at 4 P.M. unbent the Fore Popsail and bent a new one, at 11 Am. took in the Waist Boat, at Noon Close reefed the Main Popsail, latter part winds from W. steering S. - - -

Sunday June 20th. First part strong Gales from S. W. to S. and Thunder attended with heavy squalls of rain and hail sent down the Mizzen Poppallantsails, Middle and latter part winds from S. W. to W. S. W. and Clear, at 6 Am set Single reefed Popsails and Poppallantsails, so ends steering to the Southward by the wind at 4 Am Open bore W. by S. 20 min. Dis.

Monday June 21st. All these 24 hours strong Gales from W. and equally steering on different Courses to the Eastward, Middle and latter part under Double and Single reefed Popsails at Noon. Lat. 23=18 S. - Long. 142=00 W.

Tuesday June 22nd. All these 24 hours strong Gales from W. to W. S. W. and equally steering S. S. E. under Single reefs. Lat. 23=19 S. - Long. 139=15 W.

Wednesday June 23rd. First part strong breezes from W. S. W. to W. latter moderate and pleasant all Sail set unbent the Fore and Main Poppallantsails and bent new ones so ends variously employed. Lat. 23=31 S. - Long. 137=06 W.

Bound to the U. S.

Thursday June 24th. All these 24 hours winds from S. W. to W. and fair steering. E. employed in setting up Rigger, bent a new Main Popsail &c. Latitude by observation 28=32 S. Long. by Chron. 135=32 W.

Friday June 25th. All these 24 hours strong Winds from W. by S. to W. by N. and fair steering E. bent new Courses &c. Lat. by obs. 28=40 S. Long. by Chron. 133=05 W.

Saturday June 26th. Commenced with strong Gales from W. steering E. by S. at 8 Am. Single reefed the Miz. Popsail, at Midnight equally took in the Fore Popsail and Fore Poppallantsail at 2 Am. Double reefed the Fore Popsail, at 8 P.M. took in the Staboard Boat, at 11 let one reef out of the Fore Popsail and set the Fore Poppallantsail. Lat. by obs. 29=15 S. - Long. by Chron. 129=33 W.

Sunday June 27th. This Day strong Gales from W. to S. W. and equally steering E. by S. sometimes under Single reefs at other times all Sail set, at 1/2 past 9 Am. while hauling home the Poppallantsails Capt. P. took a Snatch Block and told one of the Men to put it on somewhere. I know not where to leave a purchase to haul home the Poppallantsails. I was standing by the weather Poppallantsails after they had hauled on the sheet for sometime without success I discovered the Block to be made fast to the Main Shroud I merely spoke and told him it was a bad purchase he then began to swear and curse at me for not telling him before he gave me many hard words and called me a Rascal. Told him he was another then ordered me to my stateroom and to stop there until he called for me, he then ordered Mr. Gifford to take the Log Book and told the Stevedore not to wait on me. I went to my stateroom and considered myself of Duty in obeying Capt. P. command. Lat. by obs. 29=50 S. Long. 127=47 W.

Monday June 28th. All these 24 hours strong Gales from the S. W. and equally steering E. S. E. at 4 P.M. Double reefed the Main Sail Popsails and took in the Main Sail, at 2 Am. Close reefed the Fore Popsail and took in the Mizzen Popsail, at 7 P.M. took in the Laboard Boat. Lat. 31=48 S. - Long. 125=15 W.

Tuesday June 29th. All these 24 hours strong Gales from S. W. steering E. S. E. first part under Double reefs, latter part Single reefs and Poppallantsails set. - - Lat. by obs. 31=45 S. - Long. by Chron. 122=48 W.
