August 31st. First and Middle part strong breezes from W. S. W. to S. W. and overcast Steering on Different Courses from S. by E. to S. E. by E. shortened and Made Sail several times, Latter part moderate winds Main Topgallantail set so ends in Company with the Canova

August 1st. This Day brisk winds from W. S. W. to S. W. and Cloudy Steering on Different Courses to the Northward took in and made Sail several times to keep Co. with the Canova No obs.

August 2nd. First and Middle part Winds from W. S. W. to W. and Cloudy Steering on Different Courses to the Northward under easy Sail Latter part Winds from S. W. to S. E. and Clear Steering S. by E. all Sail set Lat. by obs. 50-50 S. - Long. by Chron. 55-59 W.
- Tuesday**
August 3rd. First and Middle part light variable Winds and fair Steering on Different Courses, Latter part strong winds from W. and hazy Steering to the Northward under Double reefs.
- Wednesday**
August 4th. First part strong Winds from W. under Double reefed Topsails, Latter part light winds from S. W. put the Quarter Boats out at 9 Am. Capt. P. hoisted his Boat and went on board the Canova, Steering on Diff. Courses from S. by E. to S. by W.
- Thursday**
August 5th. First part light winds from W. S. W. to S. W. Steering to the S. E. by the wind, Latter part strong breezes, P. G. Sails in
- Friday**
August 6th. Commences with strong Gales from S. W. and Cloudy Steering to the S. E. by the wind under Double reefs, at 4 P. M. took in the Jib and Main Sail, at Midnight lying under the Spencer, and Fore Stay sail, at 10 Am. lost sight of the Canova return heavy Gales and thick weather ends the Day No obs.
- Saturday**
August 7th. First and Middle part strong Gales from S. W. and thick weather with some rain, leading to the S. E. at 5 Am. the wind W. S. W. at 7 So. wore Ship and set Close reefed Topsails, at 8 So. saw the Canova ahead set the Fore Sail, at 10 So. Steered S. in Company, Lat. by obs. 46-24 S. - Long. 51-28 W.

August 11th. First part strong Gales from the S. attended with squalls of rain and hail, Latter part moderate winds from S. and fine weather Steering S. by E. all Sail set and up the Main Royal yard &c.
- Thursday**
August 12th. Commences with light airs from S. by W. Steering S. by E. at 1 P. M. Capt. P. went on board the Canova, at 6 So. returned, winds from S. S. W. Latter part Strong breezes from S. under Double reefs Steering to the Eastward by the wind, Lat. by obs. 37-16 S. Long. 48-25 W.
- Friday**
August 13th. First part strong Gales from S. and rainy, at 1 P. M. took in the Fore Top sail, at 4 So. lying under a Close reefed Main Top sail at 6 So. the wind shifted to the W. S. W. Middle part Steering S. by E. under easy Sail, to keep Company with the Canova, at 6 Am. let out the reefs and set the Topgallantails Latter part pleasant employed in Sail mending Lat. 34-04 S. - Long. 44-49
- Saturday**
August 14th. First part brisk winds from W. and pleasant Steering S. by E. Latter part moderate winds from S. W. Steering to the S. E. by the wind employed in Sail mending
- Sunday**
August 15th. First part moderate winds from S. W. and pleasant Steering to the S. E. by the wind at 8 Am. on board the Canova, Middle and Latter part winds from S. S. E. to S. S. W. and thick weather with small showers of rain Steering on Different tracks by the wind No obs. Lat. by L. R. 34-00 S. - Long. 44-30 W.
