

Not in Starbuck

Abstract of my Voyage in the Ship Lideon
Holland to the Southwest Coast & elsewhere

Sailed from New Bedford Oct. 26th. 1842.
touched at St. James Cape de Verde Nov. 26th.
off Cape Horn Jan. 18th.

Touched at Massafuro Juan Massafuro Feb. 7th. 1843

Touched at St. Felix Feb. 11th. Lat. 26=44 S.

anchored at Moshe April 6th. 1843. - 230 Sp. 20 Black

Sailed for S.W. April 21th. 1843

April 21st. lying off and on at Warhoo.

Saw 2 Right Whales May 6th. Lat. 40=17th - Long. 154=10th
got our first Whale May 15th. Lat. 52=00th S.
Long. 155=09 W. saw a Whale 2 Days previous
took the most of our Whales from Long. 152=45th S.
Lat. about 52=00 S.

Took our last Whale August 4th. 1843
Lat. by obs. about 47=00th S. - Long. 156=00 W.
saw Whales again in Lat. 45=30 S.

anchored at Warhoo August 28th. 1843
2400 lbs. 230 Sp. 2170 lbs. W. and Blackfish

Oct. 3rd. Sailed for New Zealand

Crossed the line in Long. 162 W

Took 7 Right Whales Lat. 40=643 S. Long. 160=to 163^W

Jan 25 came to anchor at Otago, went to Sea Feb. 15th.
took 4 Whales of Banks, 9 S. and anchored at Akaroa
March, on the 10th. went to Sea again.

Came to anchor again to Akaroa May 9th. 14th. went
to Sea again, May 17th. Anchored again at Akaroa
June 20th. went to Sea, 21st. got our last
Whale and put away for the U.S.A.

Sept. 13th. came to anchor at Rio, 18th. went
to Sea again.
