Remarks On Board Bark Taiton

Monday June 13th 1865 sea port
 At 10 A.M. got underway with the
 wind S.W. & commenced beating down
 the bay so ends fine breeze

Tuesday June 13th 1865
 This day began with fine breeze from
 S.W. working out of the bay at 4 P.M.
 discharged the pilot off the light boat
 and stowed the anchors & middle
 fine breeze from S.W. steering S.E.
 under full sail latter steering S.E.
 employed in fitting boats early at
 10 P.M. so ends fine

Wednesday June 14th 1865
 Commenced with moderate breeze from
 S.W. to S.W. steering S.E. & middle
 light breeze latter moderate winds
 from W.S.W. to S.W. saw several
 sail employed in fitting boats
 so ends under all sail
 At 1 P.M.
 got by fire

Thursday June 15th 1865
 Began with moderate breeze from S.W.
 steering S.E. at 3 P.M. fresh breeze took in
 the light sails at strong breeze double
 reefed the topmasts at 5 P.M. fresh
 gale took in all sail but close reefed
 m. & sail again spencer & fore topmast
 stay sail latter set the fore sail &
 took it in again
