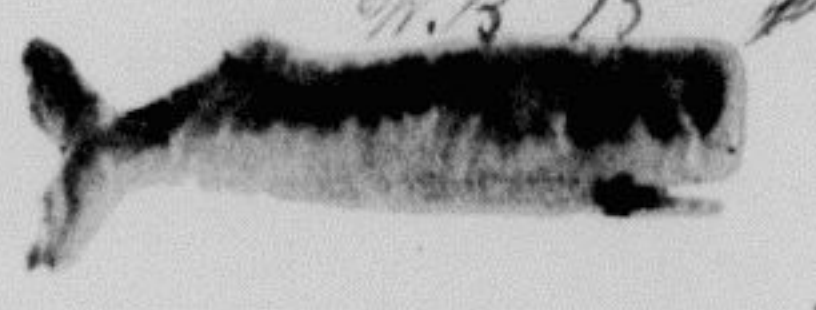

Long 49° 30' W

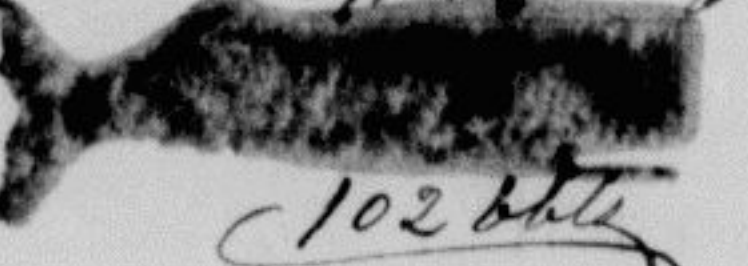
Monday March 11th
These 24 hours saw school of Sp Whales
and got 3 the larboard boat struck &
drew the bow boat got one & the W Boat

 ^{B.B. 20} Lat 32° 52' S

Saturday March 16th
Strong wind from N.E. saw Sp Whales
lost the W Boat struck & drew at
3 P.M. the W Boat struck again & got
stove the L Boat struck the same
whale and she got stove lost the
whale & lost the W Boat

Long 46° 00' W

Sunday March 17th
These 24 hours strong breeze got out 2 new
W.B. at 11 A.M. built for Sp Whales the
W.B. struck and got stove lost the whale
 ^{W.B.} Lat 34° 07' S
Long 46° 36' W

Monday March 18th
Fine weather saw Sp Whales lost the
boat the W.B. struck and the line
parted  ^{W.B.} Lat 33° 48' S
Long 47° 00' W

Tuesday March 19th
Fine weather saw a large lone Sp Whale
lost the boat at 12 M the W Boat
struck & drew at 3 P.M. the W Boat
struck again the L Boat came up &
struck 2nd boat at dark the whale
stove the W.B. with his jaw the L.R.
picked up the crew at 10 P.M. got the
whale to the ship  ^{W.B.} Lat 33° 55' S
Long 47° 55' W

Wednesday Sept 18th
Fine weather saw Sp Whales but got
none Lat 26° 18' S
Long 16° 48' W

Wednesday Nov 6th
Fresh breeze from S.E. saw Sp Whales
the W Boat got one  ^{W.B.} Lat 33° 56' S
Long 50° 00' W

Friday Nov 13th
Strong breeze saw Sp Whales going
quick to the windward, lost
without success Lat 34° 20' S
Long 50° 07' W
