Sunday Oct 5th 1868
These 24 hours light baffling air & calm
Terceira diz 6 miles

Monday Oct 6th 1868
All these 24 hours working up to Port
Praya Terceira

Tuesday Oct 7th
At 4 P.M. came to anchor in port Praya
and sent a raft of casks on shore for
water later the wind came out N.E.
got under weigh and went to sea

Wednesday Oct 8th
Wind to the E working up for the anchorage
light air & calm

Thursday Oct 9th
Employed in working in for the anchorage
at 7 A.M. came to anchor again employed
in getting water & acornity

Friday Oct 10th
First part calm Middle fresh breeze
from N at 2 P.M. got under weigh steering
S.E. with the strutting sails set Lat 38° 13'
Long 26° 18'

Saturday Oct 11th
First part fresh breeze from N.E. passed
St. Michael 8 miles diz Middle set main
royal latter under all sail steering
Lat 35° 50' N
Long 25° 14' W

Sunday Oct 12th
These 24 hours strong breeze from N.E. to N
steering S by E under all sail carried away
spanker boom Lat 32° 57' Long 23° 45'

These 24 hours strong breeze from N.E.
steering S.S.W. & light sails in
Lat 30° 08' N
Long 22° 53' W

Tuesday Oct 13th
These 24 hours fine breeze from N
steering S.S.W. under all sail
Lat 27° 08'
Long 22° 33'

Wednesday Oct 14th
All these 24 hours light breeze from N
steering to the S.S.W. under all sail
Lat by Obs 35° 17' N
Long by Chron 22° 35' West

Thursday Oct 15th
These 24 hours fine breeze from N.W.E.
steering to the South under all sail
Lat 32° 38' North
Long 21° 38' West

Friday Oct 16th
First part fine breeze from N.E. steering
S by E by Compass under all sail Middle
and latter the same Lat by Obs 30° 10' N
Long by Chron 20° 15' W

Saturday Oct 17th
These 24 hours fine breeze from N.W.E.
steering S by Compass under all sail
Lat by Obs 27° 39'
Long " Chron 19° 35'

Sunday Oct 18th
All these 24 hours fine breeze from N.W.E.
steering S.S.W. by Compass
Lat 15° 22' N
Long 19° 48' W
