These 24 hours light breeze from N.E.
steering S.W. by S under all sail
Lat 13.40 North
Long 20.20 West

Tuesday Oct 20th
This day light breeze from N.E. to N.E.
steering S.W. by S
Lat 12.02 North
Long 20.55 West

Wednesday Oct 21st
These 24 hours light airs and calms
working to the South
Lat 11.16 N
Long 21.13 W

Thursday Oct 22nd
First part calm bore for blackfish
got one to the S.B. middle light airs
latter calm bore for blackfish got three
S. Boat one W. Boat two
Lat by D. R. 10.55
Long " 21.23 W

Friday Oct 23rd
This day light airs from N to N.E.
steering S by W under all sail
Lat 9.14 North
Long 21.28 West

Saturday Oct 24th
These 24 hours light variable airs
calms steering to the S by W. Latter light
breeze from W heading S.E. W boiled out
the blackfish and bore for more
without success
Lat 8.11 N
Long 21.21 W

These 24 hours strong squally weather
working to the S
Lat by D. R. 7.00 N

Monday Oct 26th
First part calm Middle regular weather
wind to the S.E. heading to the S.W. latter
light airs
Lat by D. R. 6.41 N
Long " 20.55 W

Tuesday Oct 27th
First part light airs from S.W. heading to the
S.E. Middle of latter calm bore for
blackfish one sail in sight
Lat 6.24 N
Long 20.37 W

Wednesday Oct 28th
All these 24 hours light airs and calms
working to the S.W.
Lat 5.44 N
Long 20.42 W

Thursday Oct 29th
These 24 hours light breeze from S.W.
on different tack saw two sail working
to the South
Lat 5.28 N
Long 20.48 West

Friday Oct 30th
Commenced with fresh breeze from S.W.
heading to the west by the wind under all
sail two sail in sight Middle part
light airs and rain latter fine breeze
from S heading W.S.W.
Lat 5.19 N
Long 21.53 W

Saturday Oct 31st
These 24 hours light breeze from S
heading W.S.W.
Lat 4.42 North
Long 22.13 West
