First part fine breeze from S.E. heading
E.S.E. at night shortened sail Middle
& latter calm Lat 33° 48' South
Long 50° 15' West

Monday Dec 7th
Commences with light air from E heading
to the S.E. at night shortened sail latter
fine weather wind N.E. heading to the E.
employed in stowing down sail
Lat 34° 14' S
Long 49° 48' W

Tuesday Dec 8th
First part fine weather stowing down
oil at night finished latter strong
winds from S heading to the E. employed
in working ship Lat 35° 30' S
Long 49° 25'

heading to the W. at night shortened sail
Middle on different tack latter light
breeze from W.S.E. to E.S.E. heading to the S.
employed in repairing the foresail

Thursday Dec 10th
First part fresh breeze from N.E. heading to the
S at night shortened sail latter strong winds
from N.E. and thick weather steering various courses
under double reefed topsails Lat 34° 01' South
Long 50° 20' West

Friday Dec 11th
Commences with moderate gale from N.E.
steering from S.W. to S.E. at night shortened sail
latter wind the same heading E.S.E. weather
thick and foggy Lat 34° 37' S
Long " " 50° 00'

Saturday Dec 12th
First part strong winds from N.E. heading E.S.E.
Middle Moderate gale from S.W. heading
W.N.W. latter strong gale lying under close
reefed M topsail Lat 34° 17' S
Long 49° 30' W

Sunday Dec 13th
Commences with strong gale from S.W.
Middle Moderating latter Moderate
gale from W.N.W. heading to the S.W.
under close reef Lat 33° 55' S
Long 49° 40'
