Friday Jan 29th
All these 24 hours strong winds from N.E heading N.N.W.

Long 49° 10'

Saturday Jan 30th
These 24 hours strong winds from E to E.N.E heading to the N under short sail some rainey
Lat by D.R. 33° 10' S
Long " " 49° 35'

Sunday Jan 31st
First part strong winds from E heading to the N at night under close reefed main topsail at 8 P.M. were shift to the S.E. wind N.E Middle and latter fresh gales and rainey No Cobs

Monday Feb 1st 1869
First part fresh gales from N heading to the E weather rainy attended with thunder and lightning at 5 P.M. calm at 7 strong gales from E.S. heading to the South under close reefed main topsail and storm sails Middle heavy gales latter more moderate

Long 50° 00' W

Tuesday Feb 2nd 1869
Commenced with fresh gales from S.E heading to the E.N.E under close reefed Middle the same latter weather moderate
Lat 33° 56' South
Long 49° 30' West

Wednesday Feb 3rd
Commenced with strong winds from E heading N.N.E under double reefed Middle the same latter fine weather wind E.N.E heading S.E under all sail
Lat 33° 48'
Long 49° 32'

Thursday Feb 4th
First part light breeze from E.N.E heading to the S.E under all sail latter and Middle the same
Lat 34° 53' South
Long 48° 28' West

Friday Feb 5th
Commenced with fine breeze from E.N.E heading S.E under all sail Middle & latter fine breeze from N.N.E heading E saw one sail and a large cut squid
Lat 35° 14' South
Long 46° 32' West

Saturday Feb 6th
Beginning with fine weather and fine breeze from N heading E.N.E under all sail Middle wind N.E backed to the N.N.W. latter the same
Lat 34° 33' South
Long 46° 00' West

Sunday Feb 7th
Commenced with strong winds from N.E heading N.N.W. under double reefed Middle took in the S. topsail latter under whole topsails
