Commenced with strong winds from E.N.E.
at 3 P.M. spoke the Wave Lat 5 P.M.
put Mr. Perkins aboard of he also put
some letters aboard Middle part steering
S under double reefed latter More moderate
under topsails weather thick Lat 32° 10' S
Long 44° 45' W

Saturday Feb 20th
Began with strong winds from W.S.W. heading
S.W. under double reefed topsails Middle
look in the fore topsail latter light gale
under short sail wind W heading
Lat 33° 30' S
Long 44° 48' W

Monday Feb 22nd

S.E. heading to the S.W. under close reefed main
topsail Middle More moderate latter much the
same wind from S.E. to E steering from W.S.W. to
W.N.W. under short sail weather equally
Lat 33° 48' South
Long 46° 10' West

Tuesday Feb 23rd
Commenced with strong winds from E heading to
the N.N.E. under short sail latter fine weather
wind N.N.E. heading to the N.W. took in the S. Boat
put her overhead and put A old boat on the bow
crane and flitted the the bow & waist boats aft
Lat 33° 03' S
Long 47° 00' W

Wednesday Feb 24th
Commenced with fine breeze from N.W.E. steering
various courses saw one sail Middle strong arms
under short sail latter light variable air & calms
Lat 33° 24' S
Long 46° 47' W

Thursday Feb 25th
First part fine breeze from S.W. heading S.E. under
all sail Middle under short sail latter under
all sail wind from N.W. to W heading to the S.W.
Lat 34° 08' S
Long 46° 34' W
