Friday Feb 26th 1869
Commenced with fine breeze from N.W.
At 3 P.M. tacked ship to the N. Middle under
short sail latter Moderate gale from W
under short sail heading N.W. at 11 P.M.
saw a large breach & points of the weather bow
Lat 33.25 South
Long 46.127 West

Saturday Feb 27th
This day begins with Moderate gale from W at
1 P.M. wore ship to the S.W. Middle weather more
Moderate wind. I wore ship to the W latter
Strong winds from S.E. heading from S.W. to W
under double reef saw several Merchant vessels
Lat 33.28 S
Long 46.149 W

Sunday Feb 28th
Commenced with strong breeze from S to S.E. at
2 P.M. tacked to the E Middle wore ship to the
S.W. latter fine heading to the N.W. under
all sail
Lat 33.24 S
Long 46.180 W

Monday March 1st 1869
Beginning with fine weather and light breeze
from S to S.E. heading to the S.W. under all sail
at 2 P.M. tacked to the E at 5 P.M. boarded the American
Barge Olivia Davis of Philadelphia 45 days from
New York bound to San Francisco Middle calm
latter light breeze from various points working
to the S.E.

Commenced with light breeze from N.W. to N heading
to the E.S.E. some rain Middle fine wind S.W. heading
S.E. with main yard aback latter fine weather &
fine breeze from S.W. heading S.E. under all sail

Long 46.14 W
By Lunar 46.10 W

Wednesday March 3rd
This day begins with fine breeze from W steering from
E.S.E. to N.E. at night took in sail Middle heading to
the W the main yard aback latter light breeze from
S.W. heading S.W. under all sail saw cutt squid
and Porpoises &c
Lat 33.57 S
Long by Chron 46.100 W
By Lunar 46.102 W

Thursday March 4th
Commenced with light breeze from S heading W
Middle calm latter the same employed in
setting up the mizzen rigging saw the remains
of a Sp. Whales case squid &c
Lat 33.50 S
Long 46.129 W

Friday March 5th
First part calm Middle light breeze from
N.E. heading to the N.W. Middle hauled the
Main yard aback latter strong winds from N.E.
to N.W. heading to the N.W. by the wind saw
grampuses & cutt under double reef
Lat 33.17
Long 47.10
