

Remarks On Board Barque Titon Of New Bedford M. E. Snell Master

Wednesday April 14th 1869

Commenced with fine breeze from E steering N.W. under all sail at night double reefed Middle on different tack later he to the S.E. under double reefed strong breeze from E.N.E. and some squally. Lat by Obs 29° 10' 00" Long by Obs 45° 45' 00"

Thursday April 15th

Commenced with strong breeze from E heading S.E. later fine weather and fine breeze from E.S.E. heading N.E. under all sail. Lat by Obs 29° 26' 00" Long by Obs 46° 54' 00"

Friday April 16th Fine 24 hours fine weather and breeze from S.E. & E. on different tack later steering S.W. under all sail. Lat by Obs 29° 38' 00" Long by Obs 47° 25' 00"

Saturday April 17th

Fine 24 hours commences with fine breeze from E steering S.W. by S under all sail at night double reefed and steered S at 11 P.M. luffed to the wind with the main yard aback heading S.E. later strong breeze from E.N.E. heading S.E. Lat by Obs 30° 48' 00" Long by Obs 48° 52' 00"

Sunday April 18th

Commenced with strong breeze from N.E. by E heading S.E. under single reef at 2 P.M. were ship to the N Middle under double reefed later under whole topsails. Lat by Obs 29° 36' 00" Long by Obs 48° 45' 00"

Monday April 19th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N.E. steering S.W. by N under all sail. Lat by Obs 27° 38' 00" Long by Obs 46° 15' 00"

Tuesday April 20th

Commenced with fine breeze from N.E. steering W.N.W. under all sail Middle light breeze from N later the same at 6 A.M. made the land bearing W.N.W. 30 miles by E end of St. Bartholomew but the steering. Lat by Obs 27° 32' 00" Long by Obs 46° 10' 00"

Wednesday April 21st

Becoming with light breeze from N.E. to S.E. steering in for the land at dark prospects to bar in S.W. 3 miles at 10.30 P.M. came to anchor of St. Cruz in 4 fathoms of water later blowing strong from N.E. and many attended with thunder & lightning.

Thursday April 22nd

Commenced with weather clearing off employed in washing ship later S. Boat went up town to enter the ship.

Friday April 23rd

Fine 24 hours fine weather employed in getting wood & water.

Saturday April 24th

Fine weather employed in getting wood & water.

Sunday April 25th

Fine weather at anchor. Webster Wagner Chas. Egan Cornelius Lacom Oscar Leonard deserted.
