Monday April 26th Good weather at anchor caught the deserters and put them in irons and Wm. Rebede as he refused duty

Tuesday April 27th Fine weather employed in port duty Frank Ashton deserted so ended five men in irons

Wednesday April 28th Fine weather employed in painting ship five men in irons

Thursday April 29th Fine weather one watch on liberty so ended the above mentioned men in irons

Friday April 30th Good weather employed in port duty one watch came off from liberty 5 men missing sent the 1st watch on liberty

Saturday May 1st Fine weather the 1st watch came off with four more missing the men that were in irons turned to their duty so ended sent the 1st watch on liberty

Sunday May 2nd Sunday Fine weather employed in getting wood 1st watch came off Steward missing sent the 1st watch on liberty

Monday May 3rd 1869 Fine weather employed in port duty Barge George Capt Davis arrived here today bound home 200 \$th 300 \$th all told

Tuesday May 4th Good weather painting ship none of the deserters returned

Wednesday May 5th All these 24 hours rainy weather the deserters still missing

Thursday May 6th Fine weather employed in getting off recruits

Friday May 7th Fine weather went up town & shipped two men the George sailed and Draco arrived with 200 \$th also the ship Thomas Dickason bound home caught one of the deserters brought him onboard & put him in irons

Saturday May 8th Fine weather employed in breaking out oil 1st to send home in the Dickason

Sunday May 9th Fine pleasant weather at anchor

Monday May 10th Fine weather and strong breeze from N.E. went up town to ship men and clear the ship shipped four men
