Tuesday July 20th 1869

Boats off cruising for whales
At night came onboard

Wednesday July 21st

Boats off cruising for whales

Thursday July 22nd

Strong breeze boats off cruising
At 1 P.M. the 2nd mate landed and Wm
S. Robeson Paul Berk and were arrested and
brought onboard also John Coxswain
deserted while cutting wood

Friday July 23rd

Boats off cruising at night
came onboard John Coxswain still missing

Saturday July 24th

Boats off cruising saw two whales

Sunday July 25th

Boats off cruising Coxswain not returned

Monday July 26th

Strong winds & squally boats cruising

Tuesday July 27th

Boats cruising John Coxswain
returned this day

Wednesday July 28th

Boats cruising the S. Boat struck
A bow & calf and shot the line off with
A bomb lance so lost the whale

Thursday July 29th

Boats off looking for whales

Triton Of New Bedford At L. Snell Master

Friday July 30th

Thick & raining boats off looking for whales

Saturday July 31st

Cruising for whales saw three

Sunday Aug 1st

Strong breeze L. & W. boats off cruising
S. & B. boats onboard at 3 A.M. look for
whales, mated with the Admiral Blake
the S. Boat struck and the whale ran
off shore the schooner followed the boat
out of sight of the ship



Monday Aug 2nd

Boats off looking for whales
have not seen the schooner and
S. boat yet

Tuesday Aug 3rd

L. & B. boats off looking for whales
the schooner not returned yet

Wednesday Aug 4th

Fine weather two boats off
looking for whales the schooner still
at sea the Abigail Taylor came in
at anchor

Thursday Aug 5th

Two boats off cruising for
whales the S. Boat returned the
schooner 25 miles from the land too the
ward

Friday Aug 6th

Boats off cruising saw 2 whales
