Saturday Aug 7th 1869 These 24 hours strong winds squally boats off cruising

Sunday Aug 8th Boats off cruising saw four whales

Monday Aug 9th Boats looking for whales saw two brought 19 bbls of oil from Admiral Blake half of the whale got in Co.

Tuesday Aug 10th Boats off looking for whales saw one but did not get fast

Wednesday Aug 11th I & boats off looking for whales the other boats standing the ships chance the boat struck and drew

Thursday Aug 12th Boats looking for whales saw two

Friday Aug 13th Boats looking for whales saw one

Saturday Aug 14th Boats off looking for whales

Sunday Aug 15th Boats looking for whales

Monday Aug 16th W & B boats off cruising at 8th the W boat struck a half and the boat stove the boat lost the whale left the stove boat anchored in a bay to the windward

Triton Off New Bedford Mr. L. Snell Master

Tuesday Aug 17th 1869 Fine weather boats off cruising saw several but very wild

Wednesday Aug 18th Boats off cruising saw three whales at night came on board

Thursday Aug 19th Fine weather bow & waist boats off cruising the bow boat struck a calf and the W boat struck the cow the cow left the calf and run off shore could not get up to her so cut the line

Friday Aug 20th Boats off cruising for whales

Saturday Aug 21st Boats off cruising the Admiral Blake got fast two & whale

Sunday Aug 22nd Boat cruising saw one whale

Monday Aug 23th Boat looking for whales

Tuesday Aug 24th Boat off cruising for whales the S boat got rolled over with the wind

Wednesday Aug 25th All hands employed in getting wood and water

Thursday Aug 26th Employed in getting wood & water the Blake sunk a whale in 40 fathoms
