Friday Aug 27th Fine weather employed in getting recruits onboard & getting ready for sea

Saturday Aug 28th Fine weather at 9 P.M. got underway Anthony P. Bente 2nd Officer Schooner Admiral Blake came on board to work his passage to H. Helena

Sunday Aug 29th Fine weather at 4 P.M. lured for humpbacks Middle & latter light breeze from S.W. heading S.E. Lat 1.08 N Long 7.50 E

Monday Aug 30th Fine breeze from S.W. heading S.E. latter heading W under all sail No W.

Tuesday Aug 31st Commenced with light breeze from S.W. heading W.N.W. at 2 P.M. made the island St. Thomas bearing S.W. Dist 30 miles Middle & latter on different tacks Lat 00.52 S Long 6.50 E By lunar 6.54 "

Tuesday Sept 1st These 24 hours light air & calm trying to work up to the land land dist 10 miles

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Friday Sept 2nd 1869

Commenced with fine breeze from S.W. heading S.E. under all sail Middle on different tacks latter fresh breeze at 10.30 A.M. Edward Ledy fell overboard, lured a boat but he went down before the boat got to him Lat 00.03 N Long 7.48 E

Friday Aug 3rd These 24 hours fine breeze from S.W. heading S.E. Lat 00.30 S Long 8.12 E

Saturday Sept 4th Fine breeze from S.W. heading S.E. at 2 P.M. made Cape Lopez at night saw humpbacks Middle on different tacks latter lured dist 5 miles lured for humpbacks Lat 00.44 S Long 8.32 E

Sunday Sept 5th Fine weather land dist 5 miles lured for humpbacks at 3 P.M. L. boat struck the W boat got fast to the same whale the W boat drew and the L. boat parted so lost the whale latter fine breeze from S.W. heading W.N.W. Lat 00.56 S Long 7.25 E

Monday Sept 6th Fine breeze from S.W. heading W by N under all sail at 7 A.M. made Annobon bearing S Dist 10 miles at noon came to anchor in 7 fathoms the Brig Herald & Grace Lathrop at anchor here
