Tuesday Sept 2nd 1869

Boats off cruising for whales saw two at night came on board

Wednesday Sept 3rd

Boats off looking for whales saw none at night came on board

Thursday Sept 4th

Boats off looking for whales saw one at 2 P.M. the Bow boat returned to the ship Charles Webb seen struck used all means to bring him two but of no use he is insensible

Friday Sept 5th

Boats off looking for whales several men down sick with the fever Webb remain in about the same state

Saturday Sept 6th

Fine weather two boats off looking for whales

Sunday Sept 7th

Fine weather 2 Bow boats off cruising the bow boat went on the 4th bow & half and did not start the whale about 4 fathoms from the boat

Monday Sept 8th

Two boats off cruising the Lathrop got a whale John Brown went on board the Lathrop so ends getting potatoes & wood

Tuesday Sept 15th 1869

Two boats off cruising the other boat getting recruits

Wednesday Sept 16th

Boats off cruising several men got sick the 2nd mate one of them

Thursday Sept 17th

Two boats off cruising the Herald got a humpback and sunk him employed in getting recruits

Friday Sept 18th

Two boats off cruising saw one

Saturday Sept 19th

Employed in getting water & recruits so ends this day 8 men sick

Sunday Sept 20th

Fine weather boats off looking for whales saw none

Monday Sept 21st

Fine weather and fine breeze from S.W. at 8 A.M. got underway so ends heading S.E.

Tuesday Sept 22nd

Fine breeze from S.W. heading S.E. at 2 P.M. fired for blackfish got two of them Merrill & latter heading S.E. wind S.W. At 2.00 P.M. Log 6.32 E
