

Remarks On Board Barge

Saturday Oct 23rd 1869

Commenced with strong winds from S.E. heading S.S.W. under all previous sail so ended there 24 hours

Lat 18° 58' South

Long 6° 40' West

Sunday Oct 24th

Then 24 hours light breeze from S.E. to S.S.E. heading on the port tack by the wind under all sail

Lat 20° 34' S

Long 7° 15' W

Monday Oct 25th

All these 24 hours light breeze from S to S.S.E. heading to the S.W. under all sail employed in repairing the S Boat so ended this saw black fish

Lat 21° 27' S

Long 8° 00' W

Tuesday Oct 26th

First & Middle part light airs and calms latter strong breeze from S.S.E. heading S.W. with light sails

Lat 22° 00' South

Long 8° 30' West

Wednesday Oct 27th

First & Middle part light breeze from S.S.E. heading to the S.W. latter fresh breeze from S.E. heading S.S.W. employed in painting the S Boat

Lat 23° 24' South

Long 9° 05' West

By Lunar 9° 02' "

Thursday Oct 28th

Then 24 hours fine breeze from S.E. to S.S.E. heading S.S.W. by the wind variously employed

Lat 25° 18' S

Long By Chron 9° 13' W

By Lunar 9° 05' W

Friday Oct 29th 1869

All these 24 hours fine weather and light breeze from S.E. to E.S.E. heading to the S by the wind under all sail one sail in sight

Lat 27° 00' South

Saturday Oct 30th

Commenced with light breeze from E heading S.S.E. at 3 P.M. spoke Barge Orna Taff of New Bedford Capt. Howland 6 months out 25 Sp Middle light air latter much the same steering S.S.E. employed in repairing the fore topsail

Lat 27° 47' South

Long 8° 00' West

Sunday Oct 31st

Then 24 hours light breeze from N.N.E. to N steering S under all sail

Lat 28° 46' South

Long 7° 54' West

Monday Nov 1st

Commenced with fine breeze from N steering S under all sail saw finbacks Middle the same latter some foggy so ended this day

Lat By Chron 30° 00'

Long " " " 7° 30'

Tuesday Nov 2nd

Commenced with light breeze from N steering S by W Middle and latter strong breeze saw finbacks

Lat By Chron 32° 20'

Long " " " 7° 32' W

Wednesday Nov 3rd

Commenced with strong winds from N.N.W. steering S Middle fresh gale double reefed latter much the same saw finbacks so ended steering S by Compass

Lat 35° 18' S

Long 5° 10' W
