

Remarks On Board Barge

Wednesday Feb 2nd 1870

First part calm Middle fine breeze from N heading to the W under short sail latter steering to the S.E under all sail two sails in sight so ends this day Lat 34.08 S Long 6.00 W

Thursday Feb 3rd

Commenced with fresh breeze from N steering to the S.E at night shortened sail and luffed to the wind latter under all sail heading E by N by the wind Lat 33.53 S Long 4.15 W

Friday Feb 4th

First part fresh breeze from N heading E at night took in sail and tacked to the W latter fine under all sail heading W N W saw cowfish Lat 33.48 S Long 3.50 W

Saturday Feb 5th

These 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze from N heading W N W under all sail saw porpoises Lat 33.52 S Long 5.00 W

Sunday Feb 6th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N N W heading W at night spoke Schooner Washington Freeman Middle wind halling to the S latter Moderate gales from S steering N W under double reefed two schooners in sight Lat 33.40 S Long 5.40 W

Monday Feb 7th

These 24 hours Moderate gales from S on different tacks under short sail Lat 33.40 S Long 7.40 W

Tuesday Feb 8th

Strong winds from S under short sail on diff tacks No Id

First part strong breeze from S.E heading E. N. E under close reefed latter moderate two sails in sight Lat 33.07 S Long 7.00 West

Thursday Feb 8th

fresh breeze from S.E on different tacks spoke Ship Noerva Length Lat 33.00 S Long 7.15 W

Friday Feb 9th

Fine weather and light air from S heading to the E at night spoke Bark Deedemona of N Bedford Capt Davis 7 months out 100 lbs Whale oil Lat 32.50 S Long 7.10 W

Saturday Feb 10th

These 24 hours fine weather and light breeze from S.W steering to the E saw Grampus Lat 33.08 South Long 5.10 West

Sunday Feb 11th

These 24 hours fine breeze from W steering E. S. E Lat 33.20 S Long 4.20 W

Monday Feb 12th

Light air from W steering E. S. E one sail in sight Lat 33.06 S Long 3.45

Tuesday Feb 13th

Fine breeze from W steering E. S. E spoke Brig Herald of Marion Capt Keelley 14 months out 300 lbs Whale 150 sp Lat 33.06 S Long 2.13 W

Wednesday Feb 14th

Fine breeze from W steering E. S. E under all sail Lat 32.34 S Long 00.30 W
