Thru 24 hours fresh trades from S
on different tack, saw on finback, Lat 22.00 S

Monday Feb. 28th
Fresh breeze from S steering various
courses in search of whales, Lat 21.06 S
Long 9.40 E

Tuesday March 1st
Fresh breeze from S at night made
all sail and steered for St. Helena as
the Cooper is getting worse, Lat 20.18 S
Long 8.00 E

Wednesday March 2nd
Fine trades steering N.W. under
all sail, Lat 19.08 S
Long 4.45 E

Thursday March 3rd
Fine breeze from S.S.E. steering
N.W. under all sail, Lat 18.30 S
Long 1.45 E

Friday March 4th
Light breeze from S.S.E. steering
N.W. by W under all sail, Lat 18.04

Fine breeze from S.E. steering
