Tuesday July 3rd

First part thick sunny weather
Middle the same latter fine clear
weather sun nothing

Wednesday July 4th

First part fine clear weather
Middle and latter part sunny
 breeze from N.W. with thick shiny weather

Thursday July 5th

First part strong gale from N.W. ship
lying at anchor in the bay under reefed sails
at 3 P.M. started with all hands anchored and
began they were going anywhere but got off with loss
of jib, foremast and topmast Mast, and
of latter part weather the same ship under
all sail main top sail

Friday July 6th

First part light hazy air with heavy small
thick shiny weather at sunset saw number of
sails Middle and latter part light
breeze (air)

Saturday July 7th

L.B. First part light breeze from S.W.
at 6 P.M. leaved then Banks for E. Wind
jib foremast bent struck get repaired
and lost the jib & Mast and latter
part calm

Sunday July 8th

First part calm Middle the same
latter part calm in the Bay
